Former Boy Scout Leader Sentenced To 4 Years In Prisor, In Molestation Case

Elmer L. Blough, a former Smithville Boy Scot leader, was sentenced to four years in prison thi morning for molesting Scouts during campouts i

-Wayne County Common Pleas Judge Robert J Brown ordered Blough, 55, 313 S. Summit St. Smithville, to the Orient Correctional Institute for three counts of gross sexual imposition and two counts of sexual imposition for incidents that took place while the youths were with Smithville Troop

Blough was the troup's leader of the Order of the Arrow. He had been a part of the organization for 15-20 years.

Some of the incidents took place at the Wayne County Coon Hunters' Club on Honeytown Road while others took place at Stoller's Pond, private property in Milton Township, where Scouts hac

"Given the serious nature of the charges, you not only violated the law, but you violated the trusthat these children placed in you," Brown tolc Blough before sentencing.

Brown said a pre-sentence report of the incidenshowed that two of the youths who were molestec are continuing to have psychological problems because of the incidents.

Brown sentenced Blough to consecutive two-year sentences on two of the gross sexual imposition charges. He sentenced Blough to another concur rent term of two years for the third charge.

He also ordered Blough to serve 90 days in the Wayne County jail for each of the two sexua imposition charges, which involved the molesting o

UNDER OHIO LAW, sexual imposition is a misdemeanor; therefore, the sentences will merge with the felony charges of gross sexual imposition.

Blough said he had nothing to say to Brow. before sentencing. After the judge left the court room, Blough told his family "I won't be coming back. I won't be coming back." He directed hi attorney Gust Goutras of Canton "to transfe

everything to my wife."

County officials confirmed that the incidents involving the youths took place at both the Coon Hunters' Club and at the private pond.

In one incident at Stoller's Pond last summer, Blough allegedly used a blanket or towel to help dry a 12year-old boy who had just finished swimming. Blough, according to officials, then molested the youth while the boy was still in his swimming trunks.

Officials said Blough also had touched and massaged other youths

on occasion.

Blough's touching also led to his molesting another 12-year-old boy in December 1986 at the Coon Hunters' Club.

Authorities said the incident began when Blough asked the boy, who was wearing just a T-shirt and shorts, if he wanted to stay warmer by sleeping with Blough, instead of sleeping alone with only one blan-

Officials said Blough pulled the youth's shorts down and began touching the boy's genitals. The youth did not know what to do and simply tried to roll over, however, the incident continued, according to the authorities.

BEFORE THE campout, Blough told the youth's father that he would keep his boy warm through the night, according to the Smithville parent.

Blough reportedly told Wayne County sheriff's deputies that he only inadvertantly touched the youth, but later admitted to the

molesting.

The incidents came to light after the youths heard remarks in a Teen CAP (Child Assault Prevention) presentation by school counselors at Greene Middle School.

Blough's attorney sought mercy for his client in the case, citing Blough's lack of a criminal record and his belief that he could take a great deal of treatment.

Wayne County prosecutor John M. Williams presented the case, and cold Brown before sentencing that it "was not the most grievous offense I've seen, but (Blough) was in an unusual place of trust" to be involved in this type of incident.

Jack Johnson, executive director of the Boy Scouts of America's Buckeye Council in Canton, could not be reached for comment this morning on the effect Blough's conviction has had on the Smithville troup.

Former Scout Leader Pleads To Sex Charges

A former Smithville Boy Scout leader admitted Friday that he molested two Scouts on campouts in the last two years.

Elmer L. Blough, 55, 313 S. Summit St., pleaded guilty to three counts of gross sexual imposition and two counts of sexual imposition before Wayne County Common Pleas Judge Robert J. Brown.

Brown ordered a pre-sentence investigation, and said sentencing will be in about a month. Brown also ordered Blough to two counseling appointments at the Forensis Diagnostic Center in Mansfield in the next two weeks. Brown said the results of the sessions will be used to help him in sentencing.

Blough faces a maximum of two years in prison and a \$5,000 fine on each of the gross sexual imposition charges. He faces a maximum 60-day sentence in jail and a \$250 fine for the sexual imposition charges, which are a misdemeanors.

The former adviser of the local Order of the Arrow is free on \$2,000 cash bond. He was scheduled to stand trial on the charges March.

The charges stem from incidents at the Wayne County Coon Hunter's Club on Honeytown Road when the youths were on campouts, according to two county officials.

An indictment in the case shows that the incidents took place between Dec. 13, 1986, and Feb. 23, 1987.

Blough had originally been indicted on six charges, but one charge was dropped because the evidence in a case involving one of the boys "was much less than that in the other two incidents," said assistant Wayne County attorney John M. Williams.

Blough has admitted that he fondled the boys. In one of the incidents at the Coon Hunter's Club, two officials said, Blough fondled a 13-year-old boy's genitals.

DETAILS OF the incidents came to light after a Teen CAP (Child Assault Prevention) presentation by school counselors at Greene Middle School. The youths then met with a caseworker from Wayne County Children Services and discussed the incidents.

Blough had been involved in Scouting extensively in the past 15-20 years with his sons participating in activities of Smithville's Troop 73.

Blough, who was barely audible throughout the proceeding, only answered Brown by saying, "Yes sir." He was accompanied at the hearing by his attorney, Gust Goutras of Canton.

Scout aide may lace

Assistant Wayne County prosecutor John M. Williams will decide after a probation department investigation is completed whether to seek the maximum penalty against a Smithville Boy Scout volunteer who pleaded gullty last week to molesting two Scouts.

Elmer Blough, 55, faces up to six years, four months in prison and a \$15,500 fine for fondling a 13-year-old boy and a 12-year-old boy during campouts at the Wayne Coon Hunter's Club on Secrest Road in East Union Township.

The incidents occurred between Dec. 12, 1986, and May 18, 1987, when Blough and other adult volunteers took Scouts in Smithville Troop 73 camping.

Blough, an engineer and former church leader, pleaded guilty to three counts of gross sexual imposition and two counts of sexual imposition Priday in Wayne Common Pleas Court.

Judge Robert Brown dismissed one count of gross sexual imposition allegedly involving a third youth for lack of evidence.

Blough is free on a \$2,000 cash bond pending the investigation by the probation officials and a psychological evaluation by the Forensic Diagnostic Center in Mansfield.

Blough, a 20-year scouting veteran, was suspended by the Buckeye Council of Boy Scouts in Canton after sheriff's detectives began to investigate fast December.

One of the youths had reported the incidents to his teacher after a program on child assault was presented in school.
