

Bus driver going t) prison for rape

A Tuscarawas Valley School District bus driver and East Sparta Boy Scout leader has been sentenced to 10 to 25 years in prison for raping a 12-year-old boy who rode

A jury in Stark County Common Pleas Judge Sheila Farmer's court 100k just under three hours to find Ernest Van Fossen guilty of rape Monday afternoon. The jury apparently agreed with Assistant Prosecutor John Anthony that Van Fossen had reason to lie and the boy, who said Van Fossen molested him for a year, did not.

Throughout the three-day trial. Anthony said, no one - including Van Fossen - suggested a motive for the boy to make up the story.

"Quite the contrary," Anthony said. By telling his story, the boy faced "a great deal of embarrassment. ... Why would he put himself that?"

an Fossen was lying to save nimself. Anthony said.

Deiense attorney James B. Lindsey contended the contradictions were in the boy's story, not in √an Fossen's.

He said the boy called Van Fissen his "friend" and wanted him at his birthday party nearly 11 months after the sexual attacks ...legedly began.

Another key contradiction, Lindsey said, was time. The boy said Van Fossen told him it was 4:11 p.m. when he let the boy off the bus on Jan. 26, the date the rape allegedly happened. Van Fossen, als wife and his daughter's Toyfriend all testified Van Fossen was home before 4 p.m. that day, Lindsey said.

But a 12-year-old girl, not the attorneys, seemed to get the closest attention from the jury Monday morning. She and her mother. whom Anthony called as rebuttal witnesses, appeared to confirm what the boy had said on the stand Thursday and contradict what Van Fossen had said Friday.

The boy had testified that Van Fossen began molesting him in January 1988 and continued through Jan. 26 of this year. On Jan. 27, he told a school guidance counselor what happened, and Van Fossen was arrested.

The boy said the 41-year-old Van Fossen, whom the children called Ernie, would pull the bus into a dump east of the boy's home and have the boy perform oral sex. That was after Van Fossen dropped off the other two of the last *BUS DRIVER 1-6

three children riding the afternoon route.

The homes of the other children lie between the boy's home and the dump, and one of those children testified Monday that she saw Van Fossen drive the bus toward the dump—in the opposite direction of the boy's home—with the boy on board Jan. 26.

She also testified she had seen the bus — with only the boy and Van Fossen on board — go east and come back about 15 or 20 minutes later frequently enough for her to

k the boy why it happened.

van Fossen, who took the stand again Monday, acknowledged he sometimes took the bus in the opposite direction from the boy's home, but insisted that was because turning around in the girl's driveway was difficult in bad weather. So he'd go east to an intersection, turn around there and drive back west to the boy's home.

He insisted that took only three or four minutes, not 15 or 20, and he repeatedly denied going east on Jan. 28.

During heated cross-examination by Anthony, the prosecutor asked why Van Fossen testified last week that he'd never have a reason to go east. For the first time during the trial. Van Fessen's composure appeared slightly shaken, and he said he didn't recall that testimony.

During his closing argument, Anthony pounded on the contradiction. "That little fact tells you a lot about that man's truthfulness." Anthony said.

"These witnesses place him alone on that bus with (the boy), heading back toward the dump right where (the boy) told you these things happened."

But Lindsey underscored a different contradiction in his closing.

Van Fossen, his wife and his daughter's boyfriend all were certain he was home early on Jan. 26, which wouldn't leave time for the sexual attack, he said.

That, said Lindsey, created the "reasonable doubt" that should have led to his client's acquittal. So did testimony from neighbors and friends — adults and children — that they trust Van Possen.

Even Van Fossen's inability to explain why the boy would make up the story should work in his client's favor. Lindsey argued. If Van Fossen really were lying, said Lindsey, he would have come up with a reason.
