

Dear Sir:

Some weeks ago I received a report from one of our District Executives that some parents had called him in regards to what they considered a suspicious call to their sons from a Scoutmaster from another District. While they did not make any accusations, they did feel that some Scouting officials should be made aware of their concerns.

I then called the Troop Committee Chairman of the Scoutmaster's unit and asked him if I might visit with him to discuss a confidential matter with him. The appointment was set and the Field Director and I met with Mr. [REDACTED] the Chairman of the Troop Committee. After we told him about the report from the parents, he told us that he was afraid that we were going to tell him something of the kind for the Scoutmaster, a Mr. Exum D. Walker, had, upon accusations, admitted that he had made improper advances to one of the Scouts in the Troop. Sometime previous to that Mr. [REDACTED] had held a meeting with the Scoutmaster, the boy's parents, and the boy. Mr. [REDACTED] had sought and found a place where the Scoutmaster could get psychiatric help. The group agreed, after being told by the Scoutmaster that this was his first offense and he did not know why he did what he did, that they would keep the matter confidential of the Scoutmaster began psychiatric counseling. The Scoutmaster did begin the counseling.

After concluding our conversation with Mr. [REDACTED] I told him that I was going to see Mr. Walker and ask for his registration card and to request that he no longer participate in Scouting in any way. He agreed that the step should be taken.

We then went to the Scoutmaster's home, discussed the matter with him at length, asked for his card and ultimately received it. I advised him that he could no longer register in Scouting at any future time. I also advised him of the appeal procedure, but he decided not to make the matter more public by appealing.

I am enclosing his card. His registration information is as follows:


