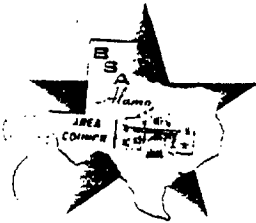

INDICTMENT-PLEA OF GUILTY BEFORE THE JURY, PUNISHMENT ASSESSED BY JURY WITH
RECOMMENDATION FOR PROBATION
STATE OF TEXAS

NO.: 84CR2573

OFFENSE: SEXUAL ASSAULT
(LESSER OFFENSE IN INDICTMENT)
(TWO COUNTS)

FELIX DIAZ

On ~~the~~ ^{the} 15th day of January, 1985, the above entitled and numbered cause
is called. The State of Texas appeared by her Assistant Criminal District
Attorney, Bruce Baxter and Michael Edwards. The defendant, Felix Diaz appeared
in person and by counsel, Ralph Lopez and Mark Stevens. Having been duly arraigned, the
defendant entered a plea of guilty to ~~two~~ ^{Sexual Assault} ~~counts~~ ^{as a lesser} ~~of the~~ ^{two counts of the} offense charged in the indictment.
Whereupon a Jury was impanelled and sworn, The State of Texas read the indictment
and the defendant persisted in his plea of guilty, and, in accordance with Article
13, Code of Criminal Procedures, State of Texas, was admonished by the Court
as to the consequences of his plea and the range of punishment attached to the
offense; and it plainly appearing to the Court that the defendant was mentally
competent and that the said plea of guilty was free and voluntary, the said plea
of guilty was received by the Court. The defendant, in accordance with the law,
requested the Jury assess his punishment. Thereafter trial was before a Jury
and, after hearing the evidence submitted, The Charge of the Court, and the
argument of Counsel thereon, on the 22nd day of JANUARY, 1985 rendered a

the Jury, find the defendant, Felix Diaz, guilty of sexual assault and assess
the punishment of the defendant, at confinement in the Texas Department of
Corrections for FIVE(5) years. But having found that the defendant has never been


Dear Felix;

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be reinstated.

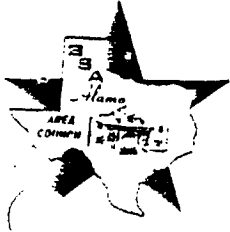

The facts: Advised by a state social worker that Felix Diaz, Jr., [REDACTED]

San Antonio 78214, 25, single, was arrested today and charged with sexual abuse of a minor. Diaz, a very active Scouter, is registered as: district committeeman, pack committeeman, Pack 565, St. Benedict's RC Church; assistant Scoutmaster, Troop 565, St. Benedict's RC Church; coach, Varsity Team 12, St. Leo's RC Church. He is a member of the Catholic Committee on Scouting there, an OA advisor, an on the staff of a weekly summer Saturday program called Cub Country. The 3 units are all strong units.

All details of the incident are still unknown to Shoemaker, but he says he believes they took place over a number of years and may involve a Scout.

ACTION OR RECOMMENDATIONS: _____

He has followed all the recommended procedures. Counseled on how best to deal

with media. He will alert region. One concern: Shoemaker just recently apparently

had another morals case there which was in the media.
