

San Antonio 78214, 25, single, was arrested today and charged with sexual abuse of a minor. Diaz, a veryactive Scouter, is registered as: district committeeman; pack committeeman, Pack 565, St. Benedict's RC Church; assistant Scoutmaster, Troop 565, St. Benedicts RC Church; coach, Varsity Team 12, St. Leo's RC Church. He is a member of the Catholic Committee on Scouting there, an OA advisor, an on the staff of a weekly summer Saturday program called Cub Country. The 3 units are all strong units.

All details of the incident are still unknown to Shoemaker, but he says he believes they took place over a number of years and may involve a Scout. ACTION OR RECOMMENDATIONS:

He has followed all the rcommended procedures. Counseled on how best to deal

with media. He will alert region. One concern: Shoemaker just recently apparently

had another morals case there which was in the media.
