

## REPORT ON VISIT WITH FRANK FARRELL 3RD

On June 16, 1981, at 3:00 p.m., Cal Stargel, Council Executive, and Doug Pringle, Executive Board member and a member of Troop 54 committee, met with Frank Farrell III at the St. Stephen's Lutheran Church Scout Annex.

Mr. Stargel reviewed the letter (copy attached) from President Groh. He indicated the reasons for suspension of Mr. Farrell's registration would be kept in confidence. The information is not being shared with anyone and only wishes Mr. Farrell to stop all Scouting activity.

Mr. Farrell asked Mr. Pringle if he could stop by the troop meeting for a few minutes tomorrow evening to say goodbye to the troop. Mr. Pringle said this would be okay but that all connections with Scouting must end at that time.
