J U D G M E N T

On this 12th. day of February, A.O., 19 88, the above entitled and numbered cause being called for trial, appeared the parties, State of Texas, by her District Attorney, Thomas L. Bridges and the defendant FRANK A. JOHNSON, JR., in person and by counsel, SHERYLL DEMPSEY, and both parties announced ready for trial.

Said defendant, having been duly arraigned, entered a plea of nolo contendere to the indictment herein on this date. And the defendant having in open court and in writing waived his right of trial by jury, such waiver being with the consent and written approval of the district attorney; said waiver is hereby approved by the Court, entered of record on the minutes of the Court and ordered filed in the papers of this cause. Thereupon the Court admonished the defendant of the consequences of such plea and that the recommendation of the prosecuting attorney as to punishment was not binding on the Court; but the defendant persisted in such plea, and after due inquiry, it plainly appearing to the Court that the defendant is sane and uninfluenced by any consideration of fear, or by any persuasion or delusive hope of pardon prompting him to confess his guilt, the plea of nolo contendere was received by the Court and is now entered of record. And the Court having heard said plea and having heard the evidence which was submitted (included stipulated evidence under the provisions of Article 1.15, Code of Criminal Procedure) and the argument of counsel, and having duly considered the same, find that the defendant is guilty of a felony, to-wit:

AGGRAVATED SEXUAL ASSAULT AND INDECENCY WITH A CHILD (Penal Code No. 22.021)

as charged in the indictment, and should be punished by confinement in the Texas Department of Corrections for a term of ten (10) years and a fine of \$ 2,500.00;

It is therefore CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Court that the defendant is guilty of the felony offense of AGGRAVATED SEXUAL ASSAULT AND INDECENCY WITH A CHILD (Penal Code No. 22.021)

to which he had pleaded guilty, and that he should be punished, as has been determined by the Court, at confinement in the Texas Department of Corrections for a term of ten (10) years and by a fine of \$ 2,500.00.

It is further ORDERED by the Court, that the State of Texas do have and recover from said defendant all costs of prosecution for which execution may issue.

And the defendant having made and presented application for probation and the Court being of the opinion that probation should be granted defendant as to confinement in the Texas Department of Corrections;

Defendant's right thumb:

Therefore it is hereby ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the imposition of sentence be suspended as to confinement in the Texas Department of Corrections and said defendant, EDAMV 1 JOHNSON, JR., is placed on probation beginning this date for a term of ten (10) years under the supervision of the Court and the duly appointed and acting Probation Officer, subject to the following Conditions of Probation.

1. Neither commit nor be convicted of any offense against the Laws of the State of Texas, any other State or of the United States of America;
2. Avoid injurious or vicious habits and abstain from the use of controlled substances or dangerous drugs in any form that are not prescribed by a licensed physician;
3. Avoid places and persons of harmful or disreputable character, including places where controlled substances or dangerous drugs are illegally possessed, sold, or used and not associate with persons with felony criminal records;
4. Obtain and keep gainful employment in a lawful occupation;
5. Report in person, during the term of probation, to the Probation Officer of San Patricio County, Texas, once each month, between the first and tenth days of the month, beginning March 1, 1988;
6. Permit the Probation Officer of San Patricio County to visit you in your home or elsewhere;
7. Not leave the State of Texas, without the written consent of this Court filed among the papers of the cause;
8. Support your dependents that you now have or that you may acquire during the term of this probation;
9. Report, within two Probation Department working days, any change of address, change of job or arrest to the Probation Officer of San Patricio County, Texas;

10. Pay restitution in the amount of determined to the Probation Officer of San Patricio County, Texas, for the benefit of Odem, Texas XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX until full restitution has been made; with fine
11. Pay to the Probation Officer of San Patricio County, Texas, a statutory supervisory fee of \$ 40.00 per month, payment being made with report, which is due within the first ten days of each month, beginning March 1, 1988;
12. Be well-groomed as required by the 35th Judicial District Court San Patricio County, Texas;
13. Pay the Court Costs in the amount of \$ 72.50 to the Probation Officer of San Patricio, Texas, with a fine days;
14. Pay a fine in the amount of \$ 2,500.00 to the Probation Officer of San Patricio County, Texas, at a rate of \$ 30.00 per month, beginning March 1, 1988, and the same day of each month thereafter until the fine, restitution and court costs have been paid in full;
15. Participate in the outpatient Sexual Perpetrator program sponsored by the Family Counseling Program, Corpus Christi, Texas one (1) time per week beginning February 12, 1988, obey all program rules, program regulations and pay all related costs of said program and remain in said program until released by the Staff of the Family Counseling Program with the written concurrence of the Judge of this Court filed among the papers of this cause;

Judicial District Probation Unit, costs to be determined of said evaluation paid in your interest by the 36th. Judicial District Unit on or before March 22, 1988;
17. During the term of probation, not accompany any person under the age of eighteen (18) years without the presence of the minor's parents or parent;
