

This case was called on October 3, 1986, for plea. Present were T. Hamilton Noll, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, for the State, and the Defendant with his attorney, James H. Hart.

As the result of agreement by counsel for the State and the Defense stated on the record in open Court, the Defendant moved to change his plea to the indictment, having waived the service and reading in open Court. The Defendant withdrew his former plea of not guilty and entered his plea of guilty in open Court, to the offense of Gross Sexual Imposition, a violation of R.C. Saction 2907.05, a felony of the third degree. At time of sentencing, State to recommend that if sentence imposed that it be local incarceration.

The Defendant's attorney stated that he personally advised Defendant of his constitutional rights, the consequences of the plea, and penalty, as provided by Criminal Rule 11.

Thereafter, the Court addressed the Defendant personally and

advised him of his constitutional rights, the consequences of the plea, and penalty, as provided by Criminal Rule 11.


The Defendant, in open Court, in writing, waived his right to trial by jury and signed the petition to plead guilty and plea of guilty to the offense of Gross Sexual Imposition, a violation of R.C. Section 2907.05, a felony of the third degree.

The Court then informed the Defendant of the effect of the plea of guilty as required by Criminal Rule 11 (3) and read and reviewed the petition to plead guilty, plea of guilty, and jury waiver to the Defendant.

The Court then determined from the Defendant's statements that there is a factual basis for the plea of guilty and the plea of guilty was accepted and the Defendant was adjudged guilty of the offense of Gross Sexual Imposition, a violation of R.C. Section 2907.05, a felony of the third degree.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND JUDGMENT RENDERED that the Defendant is convicted of the crime of Gross Sexual Imposition and this case is referred for a pre-sentence investigation, the amount of bond being continued at Defendant's own recognizance, there being no objection by the prosecution. Defendant to be present for sentencing on Monday, November 3, 1986, at 3:00 p.m.

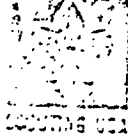
