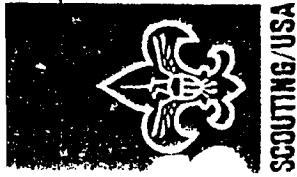

## Scouters are honored

The Appalachian Trail District of the Great Trails Council, Boy Scouts of America, presented district awards of merit to Ms. Wendy LaRocque, Frank Butler, Gregg Carmel and Richard Murphy at the annual dinner, May 5, at the American Legion hall. The award reflects service to their units, the district, community and church.

Also honored were D. Marshall Conant and Scott Behrent. Mr. Conant received the "Scoutmasters Scoutmasters Award" for his support of cub packs and Scout troops throughout the area. Mr. Behrent, a former Scout executive, was recognized for outstanding service while working with volunteers of the district.

Mr. Murphy has been an adult Scouter for more than 40 years, serving as chairman of the Housatonic and Central districts. A supporter of Scout shows, derbies and camporees, he has been campmaster for many Catholic retreats. He is chairman of the district membership committee of the executive board and liaison between the Springfield Diocese and the National Council for Catholic Scouting. Mr. Murphy is the holder of the Bishop Weldon Award, Cross of St. George, Scouter's Key and the Silver Beaver.

Ms. LaRocque is cubmaster of Pack 18, Pittsfield, and a member

of the Roundtable and commissioner staffs. Active for three years, she holds the Scouter's Training, Arrowhead, Den Leader Coach and Den Leader Training awards. A member of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church, Ms. LaRocque has been a Sunday school teacher for more than 22 years, for which she received the Distinguished Service Award.

Frank J. Butler of Troop 26 in Becket is a Scoutmaster and Welobel leader. He was a unit commissioner with responsibility for the district's special-needs units. A supporter of the Roundtables, he is known as the "cracker-barrel" czar. He has received the Scouter's Training award, and Order of the Arrow, in which he received vigil honors. He is a deacon at First Congregational Church of Becket, an adviser for the Youth Fellowship of Becket Churches, and is organizing a bike-a-thon fund-raiser (for all ages) to be held in Becket this summer to benefit St. Jude's Children's Hospital.

Gregg Carmel is a member of the Cub Leader Training Team and is Scoutmaster of Troop 4 in Dalton. He has been active in camporees, derbies and is on the staff for the Council Woodbadge training course. He has been a coach for the American Junior League of Bowling and Dalton Little League, is an alumnus of the Boys' Club and a member of the Sportsman Club. He is a communicant of St. Agnes' Church.





This letter is to advise you about Mr. Frank Butler who was recently arrested in Northern Berkshire on a Morals Charge. His present case is still pending and it involves young males of scouting age. This came to my attention because a few years back my department had an investigation regarding Mr. Butler. At that time again his target was scouting age males and he made an admission to us that he had made offers to them for a blow job. At that time he also had obscene material. When we had Mr. Butler I did receive a call from someone in scouting about our investigation. At that time I explained the situation and left the decision up to that person about Mr. Butler's status with Scouts. I can not remember the person's name. I feel being a scout leader myself that Mr. Butler is a risk mainly because his targets are scout age males similar to the boys he deals with in his troop. The potential is high I believe for possible harm to his own troop members.
