Prison term ordered for long-time sex abuser

A Boy Scout volunteer and church school teacher, accused of sexually assaulting more than 70 young boys since 1962, was ordered Monday to serve four years in the state prison.

Franklin Leon Mathias, 54, was sentenced by Union County Circuit Judge R.T. "Tom" Gooding for molesting an 11-year-old boy during a Sunday school class.

Union County District Attorney Russ West recommended the sentence, claiming Mathias had sexually abused more than 70 victims during his adult life.

The sentence carries a minimum of 24 months and requires that Mathias, 504 S. 12th St., make restitution to the victim.

In addition, Mathias received suspended one-year sentences for each of three Class A misdemeanor sexual abuse charges.

As a condition of parole, Mathias must serve 180 days in the Union County Correctional Facility for each count.

The misdemeanor sex abuse incidents occurred during scouting activities at Catherine Creek State Park last summer and at a Cub Scout outing in 1985.

The sentences will be served consecutively.

Upon release from the county jail, Mathias must adhere to 22 conditions of parole for the Class C felony.

Some of the conditions require Mathias:

- To refrain from knowingly associating with persons under age 18.
- To successfully complete a treatment program for sexual-related disorders.
- To refrain from viewing television programs, motion pictures or home videos which act as a stimulus for his deviant cycle.
- To not reside in any residential setting where he might have contact with persons under the age of 13.

Gooding spoke directly to the defendant before he pronounced sentence.

"You have a cognitive disorder so strong that only those involved can know the strength of such a deviancy."

Gooding cited as aggravating factors: the vulnerable ages of the victims, the use of a position of public trust to promote deviancy, the large number of victims the defendant admitted abusing and the crimes that were dismissed or not prosecuted pursuant to guilty pleas.

Mathias admitted he abused 10 male students in 1962 when he taught at Greenwood School.

The school district agreed not to prosecute if he avoided teaching, scouts or other activities that involve children.

"I am disappointed," said Gooding, "that this matter wasn't handled by the system in 1962 — we wouldn't have all this wreckage now."

West cited the defendant's misuse of a position of public trust and his unwillingness to accept treatment as reasons for imprisonment versus an outpatient treatment program.

A psychiatric report said Mathias "joined church and became involved in scouts to have access to victims. He planned activities so he could have contact with children."

Mathias was accused of touching his victims' genitals through their clothing.

Another report stated that Mathias "needs to be treated in the confines of a prison."

The mother of one of the victims addressed the court saying, "I have a great love for the Mathias family and for Mr. Mathias as a person but he has a problem. This must be handled fairly and carefully so that children don't lose faith in the judicial system."

Mathias fought back tears as he made a public apology to his victims and the people of Union County for his crimes.

"I hate what I have done, and I wish that I had never been born. I don't know why I do

these things ... I'm sorry about the shame I have brought upon my family."

Defense Attorney David Baum recommended enrollment in a treatment program so Mathias, a printer, could continue to work. Baum also suggested polygraph tests on a regular basis and some jail time.

"Sentencing Frank for each individual offense would be like sentencing an alcoholic for each drink he took," said Baum.

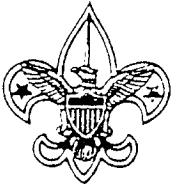

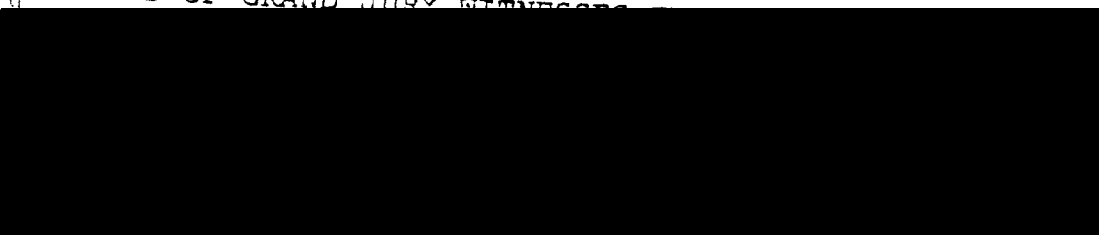

SUBJECT: Frank Mathias

On Tuesday June 16, 1987 Frank called and said he had talked with Pres. Dale Wyatt of the La Grande L.D.S. Stake and they had decided that he should resign his church callings and his Scouting positions. He was very emotional and I accepted his verbal resignation. No details were shared with me and I could only assume that Frank was having some legal or moral problems which were being addressed through the church. A couple of days later I received a call from Eric Valentine informing me that there was a State Police investigation of Frank being initiated and that it might be a good idea to remove Frank from his commissioner position to avoid prospective problems. I informed Eric that Frank no longer held any Scouting or youth related positions in the church and that what ever problems he had were being addressed through local church channels.

Until Friday, September 4th when I received a call from Eric Valentine informing me of Frank's arrest, I had no knowledge of the nature of the situation involving youth. On Saturday September 5th I learned from Ray Baum, an attorney in the firm representing Frank that he had been charged with 9 counts of 2nd degree sex abuse. I had Ray Baum call Scout Executive Phil Robins to inform him of the situation and then I called Phil to report what I knew.

Frank was removed from all Scouting assignments as of June 16, 1987, all information concerning the nature of his problem was held confidential until September 4, 1987 when he was arrested. Apparently, to my knowledge, the only people who were appraised of the situation were key church leaders in the La Grande, Oregon Stake of the L.D.S. Church and the La Grande 2nd Ward, a church counselor and the State Police conducting the investigation, all of which held information in strict confidence. Although I had talked with Phil about Frank's resignation and we knew there was some kind of problem, I was unaware of what had allegedly taken place. I will not know full details until the arraignment on September 9, 1987.

Ex-Scout volunteer charged with 5 counts of sexual abuse

A Union County grand jury Monday indicted a La Grande man on one count of felony sexual abuse and four counts of misdemeanor sexual abuse involving minor boys.

Franklin Leon Mathias, 53, 504 S. 12th St., was indicted in a grand jury true bill that was returned late in the afternoon.

The incidents allegedly took place during Boy Scout outings, said Union County District Attorney Russ West.

Mathias, owner of a printing business in La Grande, is charged with first-degree sexual abuse, a Class C felony, in an incident involving a boy

younger than 12 between June 1 and Sept. 1, 1985.

He also faces four counts of second-degree sexual abuse, Class A misdemeanors, involving boys between the ages of 13 and 18. Those incidents allegedly occurred this year between January and July.

Mathias originally was cited by police on Sept. 4 with nine counts of misdemeanor sexual abuse, in cases involving 13- and 14-year-old boys.

Mathias, who had been a volunteer in a local Boy Scout troop and was a former district commissioner, resigned from the youth organization in June.
