Because of an incident involving a student here Mr. Schon submitted a resignation about the fifth of December for "personal reasons." The nature of this incident makes a positive reference a very difficult thing to submit to you, although his teaching record with us was fine up to that time.

The enclosed reference, naturally, must indicate something, in order to protect successive school systems from a repeat of a similar incident. Naturally, I regret this but feel that my professional obligation requires me to do so in order to protect boys and girls in all instances.

Thank you for your letter of April 22 concerning one Fred E. Schon who was formerly registered as Cubmaster of Pack 154 from January 31, 1963 to January 31, 1964. We have placed the information you have provided in our file.

Before we can take final action regarding this matter, however, we would very much appreciate knowing further details concerning this situation. Your letter states he was released from his employment as a teacher due to proof of homosexual conduct. What is the nature of this proof? In cases of this nature it is always helpful if we can obtain any available substantiating statements or documents so that we may have them for future reference and identification purposes.

Enclosed is a confidential record sheet which we will also appreciate your filling out and returning to us, together with the above requested information. This will then enable us to identify Mr. Schon should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program.
