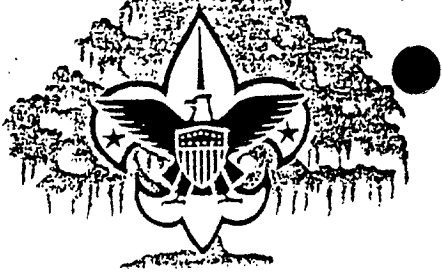

Our officers have revoked the registration of two volunteers, William J. "Bill" Burke and Fred L. Rice, Sr. Also, the registration of Danny C. Phillips was not permitted.

Attached is supporting documentation for the action taken. It is believed Mr. Burke will appeal so I am forwarding the appropriate copies to the South Central Region. Mr. Burke also admitted to striking a "hysterical" child sometime in 1984 at a Boys Club game. The parents pressed charges and he was found guilty. He lied to us concerning his Florida conviction in 1973.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed please write to me within 60 days of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted or reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.

ANSWER TO MOTION FOR DISCOVERY UNDER ARTICLE 716 ET. SEQ.
OF THE LOUISIANA CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE

NOW INTO COURT, through the undersigned Assistant District Attorney comes the State of Louisiana and answers defendant's motion paragraph by paragraph as follows:

1.

The State will so comply; copy attached.

On May 9, 1984, in response to questioning by Deputies R. Medaries and R. Smith of the Ouachita Parish Sheriff's Office, at the courthouse annex, Ouachita Parish, Louisiana. Defendant, after being advised of his rights and signing a constitutional rights waiver form, advised the deputies that,

...Rice told the deputies that he and [REDACTED] left the Smith Street Body Shop where they work at about 5:30 P.M. on May 7, 1984 in Rice's van. Rice stated that they stopped at Safeway Grocery where Rice bought some groceries for Rice's grandmother. Rice stated that the two then drove to his grandmother's house on Okaloosa School road arriving shortly before 7:00 P.M. Rice told the deputies that he and [REDACTED] stayed there for 10 or 15 minutes then went to Rice's camp which is located nearby. Rice stated that after arriving at the camp he and [REDACTED] began to clean house, but stopped when the electrical service was disrupted by a thunderstorm. Rice stated that the two sat in the camp for a short while, then went swimming in the pond behind the camp. Rice told the deputies that the two swam for 10 to 15 minutes after which they
