Enclosed please find documentation substantiating the reversal by the Appellate Court of the Findlay conviction for criminal sexual abuse, to complete your file.

Findlay, who is now married, has been returned to active duty with the Air Force and is currently stationed in England.

He was initially charged on seven counts, which were reduced to five by the time of trial. He was convicted only of Count III, which has now been reversed.

My information is that one or more juveniles who appeared against him perjured themselves in their testimony.

To my knowledge, Findlay has not indicated any intention or interest in reaffiliating with the BSA. He does have a number of local Scouter friends who wish his "name to be cleared".

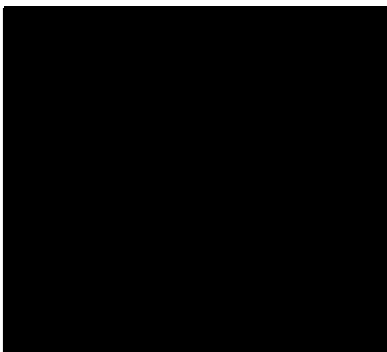


Gary L. Findlay, the registered leader of Varsity Team 6001 of this council, was indicted on seven counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse in late July of 1986 against youth members of his Team.

In a much delayed and finally protracted trial which ended last week, Findlay was convicted on one count of aggravated criminal sexual abuse. Sentencing is scheduled for July 23rd.

Findlay, a sergeant in the Air Force, has been reassigned to duty at Chanute A.F.B. near Rantoul, Illinois in the Arrowhead Council #117, with headquarters in Champaign, Illinois.

His registration was immediately suspended on July 29, 1986 by this council. He was also registered in a multiple capacity as a district committee member and served as an associate adviser to the district's Order of the Arrow chapter.

# Man Charged In Sex Abuse Case

A Carol Stream man was indicted Aug. 15 on five counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse involving a 15-year-old local boy after a month-long investigation by the Carol Stream Police Department.

Gary Findlay, 716 Bluff St., turned himself in to police through his attorney after police issued a warrant for his arrest.

Carol Stream Police Chief Wilbur Reichert said the department began the investigation following a complaint from the boy's parents. The sexual abuse allegedly took place in Findlay's apartment.

Reichert said he believes Findlay is in the U.S. Air Force working out of O'Hare International Airport.

"At this point, we do not know if he has other charges of criminal sexual abuse," said Reichert.

Dear Mr. Love:

I am extremely distressed at having to write your office regarding a serious criminal act committed against a young 15 year old scout that I have worked with since his joining the scouting family as a Cub Scout. (Enclosed Article)

I wish to register a formal complaint regarding the conduct of Mr. Walter Johnson, Executive Director of the DuPage Council, Wheaton, Illinois and his staff regarding my appeal to have a former assistant scoutmaster of my troop #191, Carol Stream, Illinois disbarred from scouting on the grounds that this adult was unfit to hold an adult leadership position due to unacceptable conduct and that further, there was reason to question his moral character and intentions towards young men.

The individual in question was a Mr. Gary Findlay, an active military serviceman (Air Force), age 28, single and no apparent interests outside of scouting.

I became suspect of Mr. Findlay's character after several personal situations involving [REDACTED] (Life Scout). I was attempting to have Mr. Findlay removed from my troop through our committee when Mr. Findlay conspired with other members of my committee to form a new scout unit (Boy Scout Team) without my knowledge. He and other members of the committee did subsequently resign and form the Scout Team #1 in Carol Stream, Illinois.

Mr. Findlay's conduct within my troop, his conspiring to disrupt my troop activities and his personal conduct towards [REDACTED] were all carefully and tactfully conveyed to Mr. Johnson. Mr. Johnson did express a concern. After one (1) week, Mr. Johnson advised me that my allegations were unfounded, that while Mr. Findlay's conduct reflected immaturity, this was not sufficient grounds to have him removed as a scout leader and further, Mr. Johnson stated that many of his staff felt Mr. Findlay was a very involved volunteer in scouting activities and a fine individual.

My understanding of leadership certainly does not encompass "immaturity". Dealing with boys 11-13 calls for adults possessing maturity, sensitivity, moral strength and emotional stability. Mr. Findlay did not, in my opinion, ever demonstrate such desirable traits, thus, my desire to remove him from scout leadership. The disbarment effort was associated with his apparent questionable moral character. Appreciate that I was unable to be more specific as to my concerns regarding Mr. Findlay's character for fear of the legal reprisal. (Libel and Character Assassination)

In Summation, Mr. Findlay has ultimately been indicted on (5) counts of sexual assault and aggravation to a 15 year old scout. This situation could have been avoided. Boy Scouts of America has a responsibility to protect and guard our involved youth. Scouting has suffered the ultimate embarrassment, a loss of trust. More importantly, though, is what this experience will mean to this fine young man.

Mr. Findlay's fate is determined, but what about Boy Scouts of America? What are they going to do to prevent a repetition of this situation?

Mr. Johnson had a chance and he failed. Boy Scouts of America must now bear the shame. Mr. Findlay's indictment will certainly be an indictment of scouting in general. Many very fine, hard working individuals who have much to give to scouting will suffer for lack of community support. I am angry and frustrated by the ineptness of this scouting executive.
