



The victim whose identity has not been made known to us or to the public, was a thirteen year old Boy Scout in Costa's troop. The incident occurred on July 18, 1987 in our council camp. It was brought to my attention on September 1, 1989 by the state police.

I offered to provide counseling for the boy to his father. He declined since the boy was already receiving treatment.

I do not expect any further activity from the victim or Costa.

Dear Mr. Costa,

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that the individual may not meet the standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide its youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, you may write me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated.


If you agree to comply with our request that you sever any relations permanently with the Boy Scouts of America, please sign and date the second copy of this letter and return it to me.
