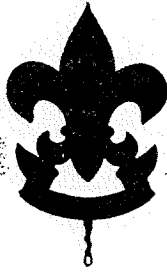

The situation leading to this request was because of improper advances by Dierker including at least two Scouts who are the sons of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

Local authorities have been advised and are presently checking for involvement in other incidents. If there should be further developments, we shall advise.
