Mr. Childs has; according to the Pennington County Deputy Sheriff Garry Buffington; submitted to a polygraph test and confessed to an unnatural relationship with at least two boys.

Mr. Childs was suspended as Scoutmaster of troop #56 in Rapid City on Wednesday, May 12th. Mr. Childs is white, age 47, scars on face, hands, and arms from a severe burn. He is single and has worked as a custodian for the Rapid City Public Schools for the past four years.

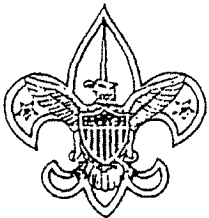
Mr. Childs is presently in custody in the Meade County jail and will stand trial.

Man charged with child molestation

A resident of the Diamond T Mobile Home Park, near Black Hawk, was arrested Thursday for alleged child molestation.

George "Curly" Childs, 47, was arrested and has been charged with two counts of indecent child molestation and three counts of committing a crime against nature. Meade County Sheriff John Egger said Friday.

Egger said that Childs was arraigned in court Friday before Magistrate William Sever, who set bond at \$5,000 for each charge for a total of \$25,000.

The charges were brought against Childs as a result of an investigation of a report made to the Pennington County Sheriff's Office Tuesday that said Childs had molested a 12-year-old boy and a 15-year-old boy.

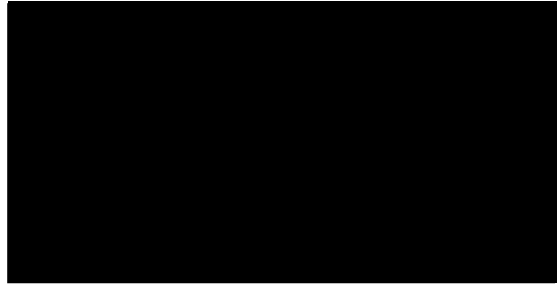
