

I have not seen Mr. orr since that time.

In 1969 on July 28th Mr. orr was referred to me fallowing a sexual episode at the boy scout camp in mid July that involved mutual masturbation with a sixteen year old youngster. The initial visit and the subsequent two visits on August 1st and August 5th completed a diagnostic evaluation. I also started him on Valium 5mg three times a day with some considerable relief to Mr. Orr.

I found no evidence of psychosis or organic brain damage. While he was harried and under a great deal compressure both from without and from within, being a somewhat compulsive inclividual, he did not appear to have a history of marked sexual deviation. He had stress not only on his job at the time with the scouts who were having organizational problems and camp staffing problems but also from his personal life. He had gotten engaged at this time as well and was having difficulty with getting appropriate relief from duty and pressures.

I regard the the tent as a s splitary one and the case was closed after his third visit.

I trust this information will be of some help to you in planning with Mr. Orr's future activities in scouting.



late in the evening, on Friday, July 18th, while he was in his tent, and a
Junior member of the Camp Staff, approached him, very distrubed and upset - he did not
know what to do. He related to Mr. that on three different occassions, Mr. Orr
