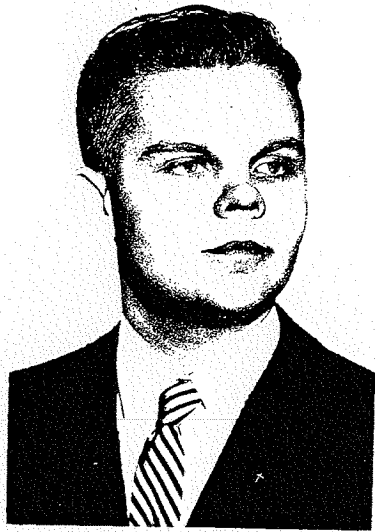





Mr. George Orr has asked me to review my old files on his case and send a letter to you releasing information contained therein in regarding his contact with me in 1969.

I have not seen Mr. Orr since that time.

In 1969 on July 28th Mr. Orr was referred to me following a sexual episode at the boy scout camp in mid July that involved mutual masturbation with a sixteen year old youngster. The initial visit and the subsequent two visits on August 1st and August 5th completed a diagnostic evaluation. I also started him on Valium 5mg three times a day with some considerable relief to Mr. Orr.

I found no evidence of psychosis or organic brain damage. While he was harried and under a great deal of pressure both from without and from within, being a somewhat compulsive individual, he did not appear to have a history of marked sexual deviation. He had stress not only on his job at the time with the scouts who were having organizational problems and camp staffing problems but also from his personal life. He had gotten engaged at this time as well and was having difficulty with getting appropriate relief from duty and pressures.

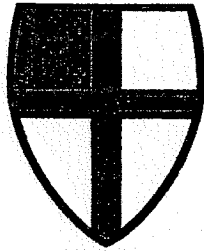
I regard the incident as a solitary one and the case was closed after his third visit.

I trust this information will be of some help to you in planning with Mr. Orr's future activities in scouting.

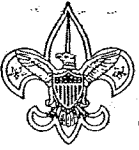

On Tuesday, July 22nd, while on vacation in Maine, I received an urgent phone call from my President, Dr. Robert B. Boyd, stating that there had been a sexual incident at camp - that a Mr. [REDACTED], and a Mr. [REDACTED]...Program Director and Provisional Scoutmaster respectively...had been to see Mr. William Wheeler, an Executive Board Member, for advice, since they did not know how to contact the Scout Executive without going through Mr. George Orr, District Scout Executive. They accused Mr. Orr of performing an indecent and immoral act on one Scout, [REDACTED] and attempting a sexual act on another Scout, [REDACTED]. Upon arriving in camp that evening, I immediately confronted Mr. Orr with the accusation. He admitted the accusation. I then spoke to [REDACTED], and asked him to explain to me the incidents that took place. Mr. [REDACTED] related that very late in the evening, on Friday, July 18th, while he was in his tent, [REDACTED] a Junior member of the Camp Staff, approached him, very disturbed and upset - he did not know what to do. He related to Mr. [REDACTED] that on three different occasions, Mr. Orr had made indecent approaches to him (he described them). Mr. [REDACTED] quieted [REDACTED] down, and moved his tent near his own. Mr. [REDACTED] then confided in [REDACTED], a close friend, and they deduced that if Mr. Orr had attempted this on this Scout, that he must have on others also. Next day, Saturday, July 19th, they enlisted the aid of [REDACTED] to find out who else had similar situation. In a few hours, he returned, and stated that [REDACTED] had had an act performed upon him the first week of camp. At this, they enlisted the aid of the Camp Nurse, Mrs. Hervey Moores, on who to tell, and she suggested the Scout Executive. They said he was away, so she sent them to Mr. William Wheeler, an Executive Board member, who in turn called the Council President, Dr. Robert B. Boyd.



After talking with [REDACTED], I spoke to [REDACTED]. He related what had transpired. I asked him why he did not speak up, and he simply stated "He was the Camp Director." I again, the following morning, Wednesday, July 23rd, confronted Mr. Orr. He again admitted the acts, and broke down and cried. I made him realize he would have to leave Professional Scouting, and asked for his resignation. I also, at this point, talked with George Orr regarding psychiatric treatment, and when he agreed, I made an appointment for Monday afternoon, July 28th, with Dr. Thomas M. Kennedy, in Meriden.
