Dear Mr. Schliesser:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to us, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be reinstated.

Bob Oswald, Uintah District Executive, called at 4:15pm and gave me the following information. About 2-3 weeks ago, Bishop Norman Haslem Naples First Ward, raleased George M. Schliesser from his duties as Assistant Scoutmaster. On 9-22-89 Bob Oswald called Dean Baker, Young Mens President, who told him the Bishop had released George Schliesser for cause for sexual reasons. George Schliesser was arrested after midnight, September 21, 1989, by the Naples city Police under \$60,000 bond on four counts of sodomy and two counts of sexual molestation. He is currently being held in the Uintah County Jail to be arraigned on Monday, September 25, 1989, in the Uintah County Courthouse. Bob Oswald will attend. Further information states there was involvement with local children not his own and stems from an incident last year which, upon further investigation, other incidents have been discovered. As Bob was reporting this information, it was being broadcast on the local radio news.

30b Oswald informed the Council that George M. Schliesser had been arraigned on Monday, September 25, 1989, on two first degree felonies on sodomy and two second degree felonies on sexual abuse. Some three weeks ago, the Chief of Police was aware the man had been charged with lewdness. He had been informed by Mr. schliesser's Bishop who had released him from his position as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 235 in Uintah District. The Naples city Court sentenced him to 180 days in jail and counseling. About two weeks ago, Mr. Schliesser was brought to the Provo Psychiatric Center where the investigator stated to the effect that the case was much worse than had been suspected and that Mr. Schliesser should be arrested. He was arrested on September 21st. Brent Feltch, Justice of the Peace and Vernal District Chairman, served in the judge's absence and was not aware the man was involved in scouting. It was the feeling of the investigator at the Provo Psychiatric Center that the man is a pedofile. The oldest child that was involved with Mr. Schliesser was six years old. There are 30 pages of discussion of incidents in the report, as held by the Provo Psychiatric Center.

SEPTEMBER 22, 1989

George Martin Schliesser (Marty) was registered as an Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 235 in the Uintah District, Vernal, Utah. We understand criminal charges have been brought against him, and the matter is in the hands of the authorities. His membership with the Boy Scouts of America will be suspended Monday, September 25, 1989. Under the circumstances, any comment on the case by the Council at this time would be inappropriate. However, it is the policy of the Boy Scouts of America to immediately suspend membership when a local Council has reason to believe that an individual does not meet the standards of BSA membership. Details of the case will be made a matter of court record. Until that time, membership will remain suspended.

Naples man arraigned for child sex abuse

A Naples man was arraigned Monday on two counts of first degree sodomy of a child and two counts of second degree sexual abuse of a child.

George Martin Schliesser, 31, was arraigned in Circuit Court on paper filed against him Wednesday, Sept. 20, by Everett Johnson, Naples City Police.

September 4 Schliesser pled guilty to a misdemeanor of lewdness and was sentenced to 180 days jail, a \$200 fine and counseling. The felony charges are the result of an evaluation by the Inter-mountain Sexual Abuse Center.

The charges involve four children ages 3 to 6. Bail was set at \$60,000.
