

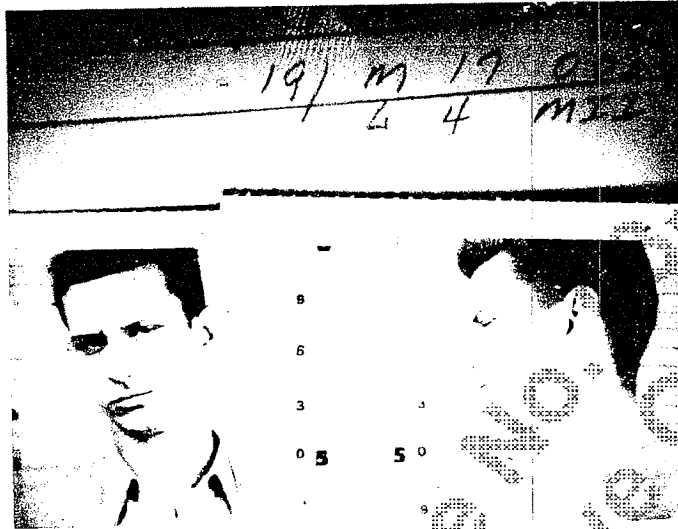

**Man Sentenced
To 5-Year Term**

 PORT LAVACA—Glen Ray Roth was sentenced in Judge Joe E. Kelley's 24th District Criminal Court Monday to five years on a fondling charge.

Roth was charged on four counts and sentences were ordered to run concurrently. He was also sentenced to 10 years probation on a fifth count, which was changed to indecent exposure.

Roth was scheduled for jury trial but changed his plea to guilty and was heard before the court.

The 75 persons summoned for jury service were impaneled and dismissed.

The Roth case concludes pending criminal cases in 24th District Court, leaving the docket clear until the grand jury meets in November.

Port Jury Returns Eleven Indictments

PORT LAVACA—Eleven indictments were returned Wednesday by the Calhoun County Grand Jury involving five persons based on 12 complaints.

The indictments returned included: Tommy Lee Shaw and Carroll Pullin Jr. of San Antonio, acting together, theft of \$3,000 from Margaret Spradling of Port Lavaca on Mar. 5, 1968.

George Rainey of Victoria, unlawful possession of marijuana, habitual criminal.

Glen Ray Roth, fondling four charges: sodomy, one charge.

Ysidro Trevino, unlawful possession of firearms, habitual criminal; destruction of personal property, burglary, habitual criminal.

Information on two indictments were withheld because defendants were not in custody.

Pre-trial hearings were set for April 19 at 9 a.m. The jury date for criminal cases was set for May 13 at 9 a.m.

Shaw and Pullin, who were

summoned before the grand jury on a swindling charge, failed to appear. They were held in contempt of court Wednesday and their bonds forfeited.

Rainey, charged with unlawful possession of marijuana, pled guilty, but the court would not accept the plea of guilty since he was not represented by an attorney. Rainey was arrested by city police on a drunk charge, originally. A complaint by city police was filed Tuesday with the county attorney on possession of marijuana.

The grand jurors reported at 10:35 to Judge Joe B. Kelly in 25th District Court and were recessed until April 17 at 9 a.m. when they asked to reconvene for further study.

Members of the grand jury include Ervin P. Hermes, foreman; Bobbie Blackman, Kenneth Dolezal, Clarence L. Albrecht, D. L. Williams, Frank Northcutt, Carl Manuel, Mrs. Roger Lynn, Mrs. W. F. Tanner, Otto H. Thyssen, David A. Peterson and David Denham.
