

14-year-term for 'hundreds' of teen sex crimes

A 33-year-old Round Lake Beach man, who admitted several hundred sexual incidents with young boys while serving as a Boy Scout counselor, was sentenced Friday to a maximum 14 years in prison.

"I just can't conceive that the probationary program suggested would work for you," Lake County Associate Circuit Judge Harry Hartel told Gregory Flosi of 901 Cedar Lake Road.

"He could have counseling from now to eternity but the

chronic nature of his criminal activity would keep from correcting his problem. He may want to change his life but he is incapable of doing it," Hartel said.

Hartel said he chose the prison sentence rather than experiment with the program and give Flosi a chance to further experiment with our youth.

Mark Pleasant, an investigator for the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services, testified about an interview he had with Flosi in which Flosi admitted he did Boy Scout work to win the trust of the young boys and then led them into engaging in sexual acts, many of which occurred at a Boy Scout camp in

Wisconsin.

Flosi said the boys were 12, 13 and 14 years old when he would introduce them to sexual activity and on many occasions it would be in the tents where the youths were camping.

He admitted 75 to 100 acts with one youth and another 50 incidents with a second boy.

Flosi told Pleasant he was attracted to the boys by their lean bodies and clean faces and he admitted that some of his victims still have recurrent nightmares.

Questioned by Assistant State's Attorney Andrew Black, Pleasant said Flosi's arrest came after one of the boys reported the incident to his mother when he returned home from the camp in Wisconsin.

"I'm sorry for what I did and I need help," Flosi said when questioned by his attorney, Assistant Public Defender David Keefe.

"The boys families trusted me. I really don't know if I caused any real serious pain. I meant no harm and if I caused any harm I am sorry. I don't know if I can ever erase what I did in my own mind."

"I want to stop what I am doing and change my life around," Flosi said.

Assistant State's Attorney George Strickland asked for the maximum prison term.

"His rehabilitation is not likely and these are extremely serious offenses," Strickland said. "To put him on probation would be rolling

explosive, loaded dice."

"The Explorers and Boy Scouts are essential organizations and it's unfortunate that 1 percent or less of counselors are pedophiles like Flosi," Strickland said.

Keefe said the conditions of Flosi's character are "wildly beyond his control".

"He doesn't want to victimize these youths but he is powerless to overcome his feelings," Keefe said, arguing for probation and a corrective sex program that is offered in Chicago on an experimental basis.

In support of his position, Keefe presented testimony from a clinical psychologist who said Flosi's profile is that of a pedophile and it will not get better over time without intervention.

A pedophile is a person who prefers children as sexual objects.

The psychologist testified Flosi has emotional problems, is seriously disturbed and depressed.






Dear Mr. Flosi,
