CASE HISTORY
CHILD ABUSE
MARCH 1988

Written complaint signed about an Assistant Scoutmaster who sexually molested at least 3 children - none scouts - over past 10 years - mailed to Council Executive.

Letter delivered to Assistant Scoutmaster with witness, by Executive - dropped Assistant Scoutmaster.

Complainant would not identify victims.

Risk Management, Registration Service, Region, President notified.

Child Protective Services notified.

Child Protective Services wouldn't get complainant to identify victims.

Certified letter from Assistant Scoutmaster wanting hearing.

Risk Management and Region called each time, noting progress.

Scouting Coordinator notified but already knew. Protested dropping Assistant Scoutmaster.

Executive urges complainant (and mother who finally called) to file complaint or see police chief - small town.

Mother contacted police chief. He contacted Scouting Coordinator who contacted Executive.

Scouting Coordinator got Assistant Scoutmaster to write and withdraw request for meeting.

Registration and Region notified and sent copy of request to withdraw from meeting.

I am writing to you concerning a very urgent but sensitive matter. I live in a small town with a very close knit community.

The town is Buckley, Wash. and this situation concerns an adult member of the Boy Scouts org., Harold Thomas of Buckley.

From what I understand, Harold is a cook and helps out at some of the camps in the summer.

I have first hand knowledge that Harold Thomas has sexually molested at least 3 boys who are [REDACTED]

For the boys sake I do not wish to disclose their identity however I will answer any questions you might have.

The boys parents do not wish to do anything about this situation however I feel an urgent need to take care of this situation before Harold harms someone in the Buckley Chp. of the Boy Scouts. I have a young son who wanted to be in the tiger scouts but I will not let him as long as Harold Thomas is involved. Some of

my sons friends are in the scouts so
please take care of this matter as soon
as possible. If something happened to one
of those boys I would feel responsible
knowing what I do. I am hoping this
can be done discreetly because the
[redacted] family is well known and liked
in this town. They are very close friends
of ours and I've no wish to harm anyone.
However my first concern is to the little
boys of this town.

If I receive no response from
you I will take this up either with
Harold myself or the police but something
has to be done.

Dear Harold Loomis:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should not be accepted. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that Boy Scouts of America membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the Boy Scouts of America seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a Boy Scout of America member should be granted.

On Saturday, February 27, 1988 - around 10:00 to 11:00 a.m., Mr. Leonhard, the Council Executive, phoned me and requested that we meet. We set-up an appointment for tonight, Monday, February 29, 1988 and had a meeting at D'Jon's Cafe in Buckley at 7:30 p.m. Mr. Leonhard, was accompanied by another gentleman. Mr. Leonhard told me that the Council had received some allegations that I had molested some youngsters. At this time, he presented me a letter, signed by you, telling me that my registration with the Boy Scouts of America would not be accepted.

Paragraph 3, of your letter, tells me that if I wish a review of this decision to contact you by letter. I am requesting a review of this decision. Also, I am requesting that you give me the name of the individual or individuals making this allegation.

I wish to have this review at the very earliest possible time. This comes as a complete and utter shock to me. Please notify me by return mail your intentions so that I am prepared to pursue this. My intentions are to get to the bottom of this charge and clear my name.
