We have been able to complete the confidential record sheet for Mr. Anderson from the very complete information you forwarded to us. Thank you.

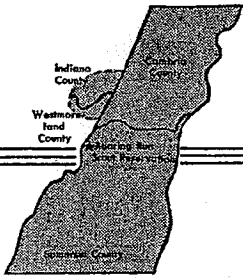

I am writing about one Harry James Anderson, 315 Park Ave., Cresson, Pa., 16630. Currently registered as Scoutmaster of Troop 92 of Council 518. Enclosed is a biographical sketch of the man and a physical description.

It was alleged that he was involved with several boys in illicit sex activity. The School Board of Cresson, Pa. and the school authorities confronted the man and he was allowed to resign because of health. The local probation officer talked with me and stated that charges were not pressed to spare the youngsters the ordeal in court. It seems that the local people (parents) did not press charges. Some of the alleged violations occurred at Scout meetings where they were part of an initiation devised by the person mentioned above.

I will not approve an application for this man in future and believe he could possibly apply from some other Council. I believe the information is complete.
