The adult roster includes a Hank Van Bealen, Jr., shown as the Committeeman and Henry Van Bealen, St., shown as the Scoutmaster. There is obviously an error shown in the two Henry Van Bealens' ages. The application shows both Jr. and Sr. as age 45.

The clincher in this whole deal is that we have a Henry Van Baalen, Sr. on the Confidential Fife. We are quite sure that our Henry Van Baalen and your Henry Van Baalen and one and the same individual. However, to make doubly sures we are enclosing with this letter and identification questionnesse with characteristics for you to check.

Our confidential file record shows that in 1966 Henry, Jr. was 13 years of abe. This would make him 17 or 18 at the present time. If this is so, he is not eligible to be a Troop Committeeman. A Committeeman must be 21 years of age.

After you have investigated this rather unique situation, please advise meas to what we should do with this Troop. We will hold it pending until further word from you.
