State Drops Sex Charges Against Man

By ANN DOSS HELMS Staff Writer

GASTONIA — Sex-offense charges against former scout leader Herbert Jacobs were dropped Friday because the man who says he was abused in 1981 and '82 can't give the dates of the alleged incidents.

Jacobs, who has said the charges are false, wouldn't comment Friday.

Prosecutor Mike Kromis talked Friday to the man, who is now a 22-year-old college student. Kromis said _ afterward he believes the young man is telling the truth.

But because the man can't give dates, Jacobs wouldn't be able to present an alibi, Kromis said. And that could lead a judge to dismiss the case before it went to trial, he said.

Even if it went to trial, there is nothing to support the man's account, Kromis said.

"I believe him; yeah. I certainly do," Kromis said. "But to convince a jury to the point that they're compelled to return a verdict of guilty, knowing this guy's going to prison, that's not going to happen."

The man said Friday he was disappointed in Kromis' decision but does not regret going to police last fall. He said if Jacobs tries to return to scouting he would fight it.

"What I want to see is to see him behind bars," he said. "I don't want him around boys."

Jacobs was leader of Boy Scout Unit 523, a group of teenagers sponsored by Lutheran Church of the Redeemer, for years before the charges were filed. The man is a former member of that troop.

In October, the man reported that Jacobs had abused him in July 1981 and September 1982. He said he didn't report the incidents at the time "because you don't want to be thought of as gay or weird."

Jacobs of 1616 Timberlane Dr. was charged with second-degree sexual offense and taking indecent liberties with a child.

Boy Scout policy required him to step down as scout leader and stay out of scouting activities while facing such charges. If he seeks to return to scouting, a hearing would have to be held.

In October, Jacobs said he had had a conflict with the young man's mother and believed the mother was using false charges to ruin him.

On Friday, the man and the mother said that wasn't true. But they acknowledged that she had whipped another son hard enough to leave a mark and Jacobs had taken a picture of the injury.

The mother said the son told her about the photo a couple of years later, and she called Jacobs to say, "It ain't none of your business what I di."

Scout Leader Charged With '81, '82 Sex Offenses

By ANN DOSS HELMS Staff Writer

GASTONIA — A longtime Gastonia scout leader was charged this week with sexually abusing a Boy Scout in his troop in 1981 and '82.

Herbert Jacobs Jr., 43, of 1616 Timberlane Dr. was charged Tuesday with second-degree sexual offense and taking indecent liberties with a child. He was released on \$5,000 bond.

Jacobs was asked to step down as leader of Unit 523 on Thursday, following Boy Scouts of America policy for handling such accusations, said David Allen, scout executive for the Piedmont Council.

"We asked him to step aside until he can resolve his dilemma. We make no accusations; we don't have enough information to make accusations," said Allen, who said the scouting office has received no other complaints about Jacobs.

Jacobs said Friday night that the accusations are false. He said he believes the accusations are prompted by a conflict he has had with the victim's mother, but he would not elaborate.

The alleged incidents took place in July 1981 and September 1982, according to arrest warrants. Both incidents, which weren't described, involved a member of Jacobs' troop who was 12 at the time of the first incident.

Unit 523 is made up of teenagers and sponsored by Lutheran Church of the Redeemer.

The victim, now a college student, said Friday he reported the incidents recently because he feared it could happen to someone else.

"When you're 12, you don't want to tell anybody because you don't want to be thought of as gay or weird." he said.

Jacobs said he has not seen that young man for several years, since he was a scout in Jacobs' troop. Jacobs said he did not molest the young man and believes that the victim's mother is using the charges to harm him.

"It's ruining my life and ruining my reputation," Jacobs said. "There's no way I can win."

Sgt. Tim Adams of the Gastonia Police Department's Youth Bureau wouldn't discuss details of the case before it goes to trial. But he said Friday that there was enough information for the district attorney's office to file charges.

Jacobs is scheduled for trial Dec. 20.

The young man also declined to say what had happened or whether the incidents took place during scouting events.

According to arrest warrants, the indecent liberties charge involves a July 1981 incident. The second-degree sexual offense charge involves a September 1982 incident in which Jacobs allegedly "engaged in a sexual offense... by force and against the victim's will," the warrant says.

Allen said the Boy Scouts barred Jacobs from taking part in any scouting activities as soon as Allen learned Jacobs had been charged. A hearing would be required before he could resume participation, he said. Same Ser

ATTACHMENT:

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the Southeast Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.

- Within 60 days, you may request in writing a review of this decision, Your request should be sent to the regional director, Southeast Region, BSA. In your request you may include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that your registration should not have been denied.
- 2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
- 3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
- 5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
