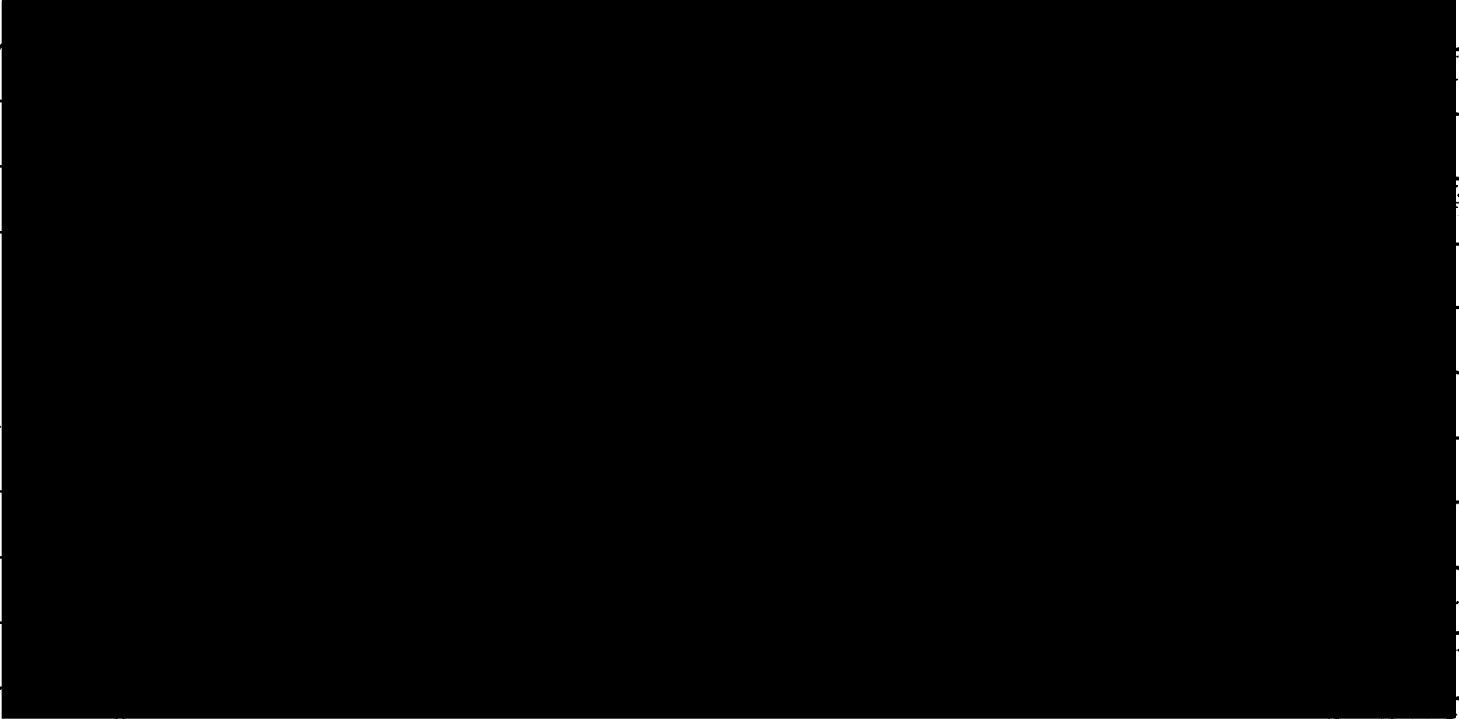

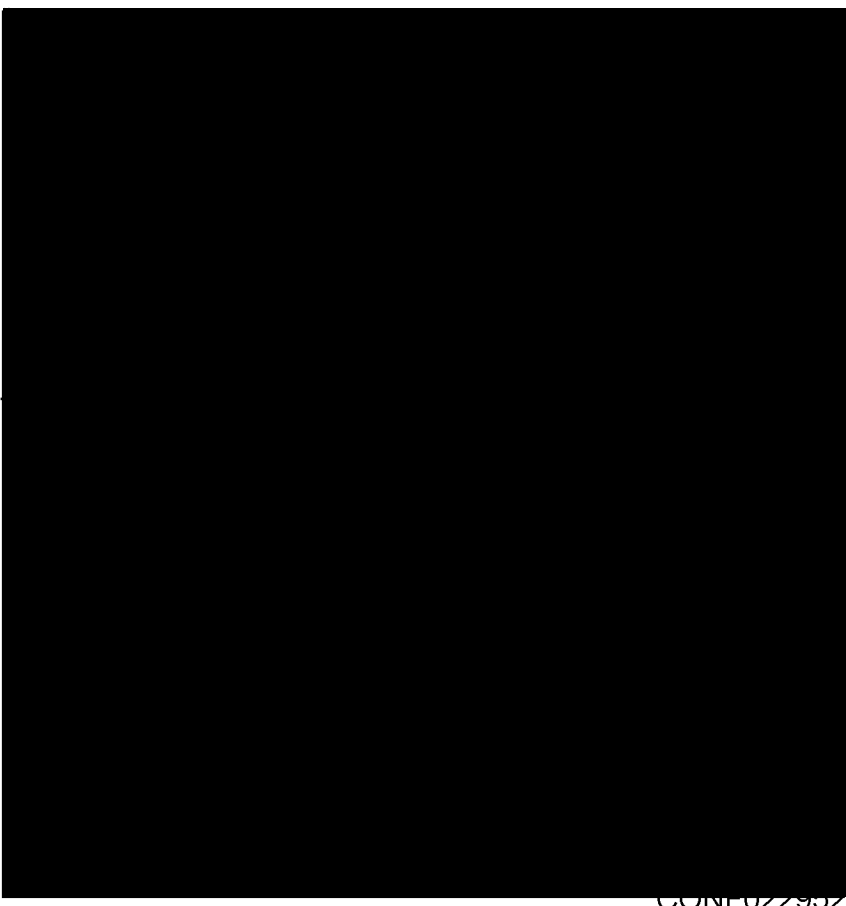

I called Ron Cook this morning about district  
matters and relayed to me that another "problem"  
was brought to his attention.

It seems that Cook accidentally met Bob Jones from  
DM district committee at a donut shop this morning  
(May 15<sup>th</sup>) and they got to talking about the Waco case  
problem. Jones said that he understood that there  
was another Scouter around that had been picked  
up by the police for sex offenses. (not specified) Bob  
said he thought the man was a Scouter at the  
Methodist Church on Waverly near Holmes (Faith United  
Methodist) Cook asked Bob who it was, Bob said  
he couldn't say (Bob is a Lansing Police Officer) They talked  
about several other things and then Ron said he couldn't  
remember who was the current Scouter at that church,  
was it that "little guy". Bob said, "yeah, Herb," and left.  
Subsequently, Cook was talking with Bill Chase this  
morning also and Ames, who is an Assistant Scouter at  
Faith United Methodist Church, was asked by Ron Cook who  
was the current Scouter (George Kent) and who was active  
with the troop. Bill mentioned among others that Herb  
Chase, former Scouter, was still registered as an Assistant  
Scouter with the troop.

6/24/85

Per request of Dave Bosher, I went to 54-A District Court to obtain a "Certificate of Conviction" on Herb Chase in order to substantiate our request to national to have Chase removed from the rolls.

The clerk that I talked to said that this case (solicited in 1980) never came before a judge, instead the defendant was placed in a diversion program by the Prosecuting Attorney's office. If I wanted substantiation, would have to wait a day in order for the court office to retrieve the file and get clearance to release it. The clerk suggested I talk to the staff in the Prosecuting Attorney's office, where I might get the necessary information without having to wait a day.

I went to the City Attorney's office, the clerk I talked to checked her files and he (Chase) was not in them, she said she would get the file from archives and give it to Daniel Nickerson (the attorney handling the diversion program) to decide to release the information. The clerk suggested calling Nickerson tomorrow afternoon (6/27) to find out if he would release the information, then we could come in a pick up a copy of the record or have it mailed.

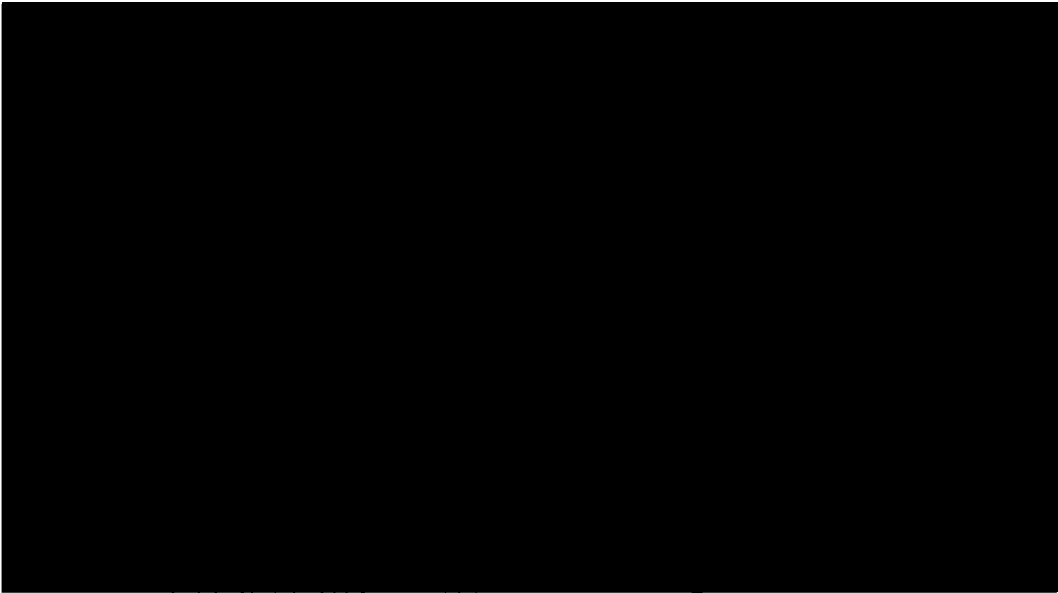
