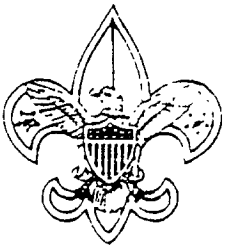

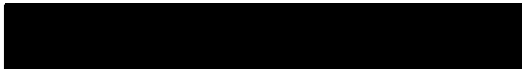

WHEREAS, the above-named defendant has been found guilty of the above-stated offense, WHEREUPON, it is ordered and adjudged by the Court that: The said defendant is hereby sentenced to confinement for a period of 10 years Probation

in the State Penal System or such other institution as the Commissioner of the State Department of Offender Rehabilitation may direct, to be computed as provided by law.

HOWEVER, it is further ordered by the Court:

- 1) THAT the above sentence may be served on probation
- 2) THAT upon service of of the above sentence, the remainder of may be served on probation

PROVIDED that the said defendant complies with the following general and other conditions herein imposed by the Court as a part of this sentence.

FIRST OFFENDER SENTENCE

WHEREAS, the above-named defendant has been found guilty of the above-stated offense, and; WHEREAS, said defendant has not previously been convicted of a felony nor availed himself of the provision of the First Offender Act (Ga. Laws 1968, p. 324).

NOW, THEREFORE, the defendant consenting hereto, it is the judgment of this Court that no judgment of guilt or sentence be imposed at this time, but that further proceedings are deferred and defendant is hereby placed on probation for the period of from this date provided that said defendant complies with the following general and special conditions herein imposed by the Court as part of this sentence:

PROVIDED, further, that upon violation of the terms of probation, the Court may enter an adjudication of guilt and proceed to sentence defendant to the maximum sentence provided by law. Upon fulfillment of the terms of probation, or upon release of the defendant by the Court prior to the termination of the period thereof, the defendant shall stand discharged of said offense charged and shall be completely exonerated of guilt of said offense charged.

Let a copy of this Order be forwarded to the Office of the State Probation System of Georgia, and to the Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

The defendant, having been granted the privilege of serving all or part of the above-stated sentence on probation, hereby is sentenced to the following general conditions of probation:

- 1) THAT defendant not violate any State or Federal laws to be adjudged by the Court;
- 2) THAT defendant make regular reports to the Adult Probation Officer of DeKalb County as directed;
- 3) THAT defendant keep the Adult Probation Officer of DeKalb County informed at all times of the defendant's place of employment and residence address;
- 4) THAT defendant shall, from time to time upon oral or written request by any probation officer, produce a breath, urine, and/or blood specimen for analysis for the possible presence of a substance prohibited or controlled by any law of the state of Georgia or of the United States;
- 5) THAT defendant pay a fine in the amount of \$ plus \$50.00 or 10% of said fine, which ever is less pursuant to the O.C.G.A. 15-21-70 and pay restitution in the amount of \$, probation fee \$ 2,000, Court cost \$, attorney's fee through the adult probation officer as provided by said officer.

OTHER CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant abide by all other general conditions of probation as set forth herein: The defendant is to be placed on Intensive Probation for the first 2 years of Probation, or until a period of time not to exceed 2 years. Defendant must later have and successfully complete the South DeKalb Mental Health Repeater's

IT IS THE FURTHER ORDER of the Court, and the defendant is hereby advised that the Court may, at any time, revoke any conditions of this probation and/or discharge the defendant from probation. The probationer shall be subject to arrest for violation of any condition of probation herein granted. If such probation is revoked, the Court may order the execution of the sentence which was originally imposed or any portion thereof in the manner provided by law after deducting therefrom the amount of time the defendant has served on probation.

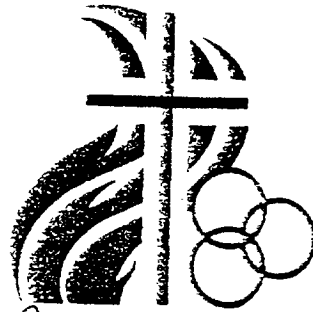

Dear Mr. Neshiam,

I regretfully report to you that I have found it necessary to remove ~~Mr. Howard Speice~~ from the position of Scoutmaster of Troop 149. I recently learned from a confidential source, whom I believe to be reliable, that Mr. Speice is serving a 12 year probated sentence for child molesting. The alleged crime took place in Stone Mountain Park approximately three years ago. I learned about this just yesterday.

I request that you utilize your legal contacts to verify this report if possible. If you should learn that this report is untrue, please inform me so that I can try to undo the injustice to Mr. Speice. But if it is true, I request that you notify the national office to prevent his continued participation in Scouting.

Unfortunately, I have only an unofficial source for this information. But as Executive Officer, I am not willing to take the chance and give Mr. Speice the benefit of the doubt. I am certain that there have been NO scandalous episodes since Mr. Speice has been our Scoutmaster because I have attended every meeting since that time. Also, we have had no overnight outings since Mr. Speice has been Scoutmaster. I am thankful for this. Yet, should this report be true, it would call into question the credibility of our Scouting program, my personal ministry and the ministry of St. Stephen congregation if we failed to take swift action.

Please remove Mr. Speice from our charter as soon as possible. Also, let us keep this knowledge between us. Of course, you may inform Duncan Locke and the national office. I plan to share this only with my Bishop, Harold Skilrud. In a small congregation like St. Stephen, I would not want this kind of information to become "grapevine" news. Especially since I do not have any hard, official proof. It would serve no healthy purpose to share this with my people, as far as I can foresee.

Enclosed are the correspondence which I have sent to Mr. Speice and the Scout parents to inform them of Mr. Speice's departure. Thankyou for your swift action and cooperation in this matter.

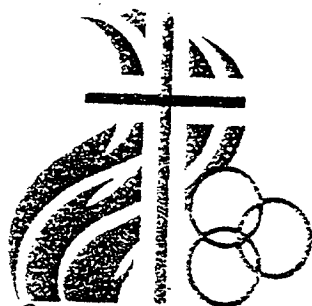

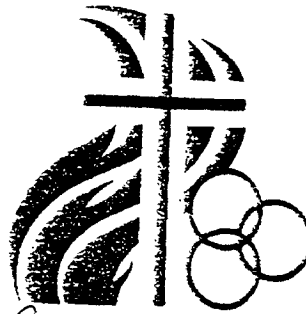
Enclosed is a copy of the notice which I am sending out to our Scout parents so that they are aware of the change. Again, thank you for your time, efforts, and willingness to serve.

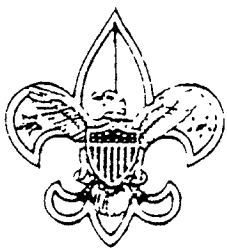

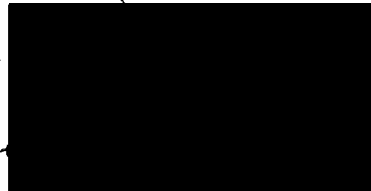
