SEXUAL ASSAULT

Ex-Scout leader gets 6 years

■ A former Boy Scout leader convicted of molesting two boys in his Kansas City home was sentenced Wednesday to six years in prison.

Jack Stewart, sentenced in Jackson County Circuit Court on his 70th birthday, was allowed to remain free on \$2,500 bond pending his appeal.

Stewart was found guilty in June of twice sexually assaulting a 15-year-old boy and of one count of assaulting a 16-year-old boy. The assaults took place as he was helping the boys plan camping trips in the "Scout room" of his home.

Circuit Judge William F. Mauer sentenced Stewart to four years for one count, six years for another and four years for the third count. Mauer made the sentences concurrent for a total of six years.

The father of one of the boys asked at a hearing before sentencing that the judge have the terms run consecutively for 14 years.

Boy Scout leader convicted

Man molested two youths, jury says.

A longtime Boy Scout leader molested two Kansas City Eagle Scouts as he helped them plan cross-country camping trips last year, a Jackson County jury decided Tuesday.

The jury deliberated more than four hours before returning three guilty verdicts with the recommendation that 69-year-old Jack Z. Stewart spend 14 years in prison, 10 years for twice assaulting a 15-year-old boy and four years for assaulting a 16-year-old boy.

"I think we spoke the verdict the public wanted," one juror said. "It was not an easy verdict."

Stewart refused to comment as he left the courthouse. His lawyer, L.R. Magée, would not say whether he would seek another trial or a lighter sentence for his client.

The jury acquitted Stewart on two charges of assaulting the 16-year-old, who was unable to recall

dates of some of the incidents. Both boys testified that Stewart asked them to read copies of photographic stories before he molested them in the "Scout room" of his residence in the 3600 block of West Roanoke Drive. He found the stories in a desk

drawer in Stewart's basement.

After the verdicts, the boys said that they were glad they had reported the crimes, and they encouraged children in similar situations to do the same.

"Don't hold back. Just go ahead and do it," one boy advised.

Stewart, who testified Tuesday, admitted showing the stories to

the boys but denied that he assaulted them.

Witnesses for Stewart testified that he had been a trusted Scout leader for nearly 30 years.

Chip McKenzie, a prosecutor, said that justice had been served and that he hoped that Stewart's actions had not blemished the

"No one should see this as anything but the abnormality of one man," he said.

Circuit Judge William F. Mauer released Stewart on \$2,500 bond Tuesday evening until sentencing and ordered a pre-sentence investigation.

Scouts accuse ex-leader

They testify in his trial that he had them read sexual stories and molested them.

A "high-adventure" camping trip to Canada two years ago was marked by a Scout leader's sexual perversions, a Kansas City Eagle Scout told a Jackson County jury on Monday.

The Scout, now 18, testified against 69-year-old Jack Z. Stewart, telling the jury how Stewart molested him on the camping trip.

He also told the jury about how Stewart invited him into his house in the 3600 block of West Roanoke Drive, where other assaults occurred.

The boy testified he went to Stewart's house to plan Scout trips. But once he was there, Stewart allegedly had him read

after first asking permission, Stewart molested him.

"I was kind of reluctant at first, but he asked me again and I said yes," the boy said.

Stewart, a Boy Scout leader who had been involved in the organization since 1969, is charged with two counts of first-degree deviate sexual assault and three counts of second-degree deviate sexual assault.

The first-degree counts carry a maximum punishment of seven years in prison, and the second-degree charges carry a maximum sentence of five years in prison.

The charges stem from the alleged sexual molestation of two boys who were both 16 years old at the time of the assaults. One boy said he was assaulted in January 1989, according to court rec-

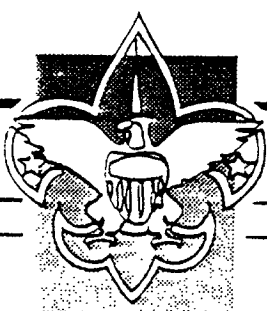
The other victim, who testified Monday, said he was assaulted several times from April to September 1988, including an incident that occurred while he and Stewart shared a tent on a Boy Scout-sponsored camping trip, called a "high-adventure" trip.

"We were in the tent, and Mr. Stewart had a story for me to read, and it was a rather lengthy story," the boy testified.

While he was reading the stories, the boy said, Stewart molested him.

The other victim has told police he also was molested while Stewart had him read sexual stories.

Stewart was arrested and charged after one victim told police last summer about the incidents. He was removed from Scout activities shortly after the organization was notified of the

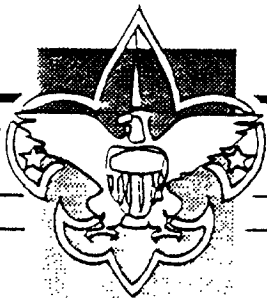

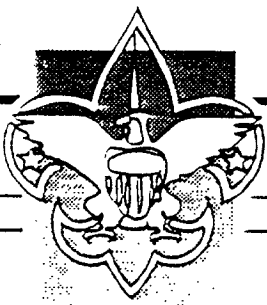

Late Friday, August 11, 1989, [REDACTED] called me from Bartle Scout Reservation. [REDACTED] was extremely upset, due to a conversation that [REDACTED] shared with him.

[REDACTED] a Scout attending camp, had shared with [REDACTED] his situation of being a victim of sexual molestation by Jack Stewart.

[REDACTED] went on to explain that the reason for [REDACTED] coming forth with this testimony was that [REDACTED] and two other boys, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were scheduled to go on another extended camping trip with Jack Stewart which would begin on Monday, August 14, leaving about 9:30 p.m.

I assured [REDACTED] that the BSA would respond to the situation before the trip commenced. Internal HOAC procedures were started immediately. Division of Family Services were contacted Child Abuse Hotline, then law enforcement authorities.

On Sunday evening, August 13, [REDACTED] called me at my home about 10 p.m. At this time [REDACTED] reiterated the urgency of this matter. More detailed information was shared with me as a result of another emotional testimony with [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] gave this account of how Jack Stewart operates:

- Selected youth are asked to attend this exciting High Adventure trip (Canada was supposedly the destination this year).
- Jack helps supplement the boys' finances to attend the trip.
- After the trip concludes Jack begins to critique the trip with each boy, on an individual basis, in his home, downstairs in the Scout Room as Jack called it.
- First Jack would show slides of the trip. Then he would show some X-rated slides, from that moving into homosexual slides, and finally begin to pray upon [REDACTED].
- Jack also used the fact that he had helped them attend this once-in-a-lifetime trip and that [REDACTED] owed him. [REDACTED] submitted to Jack's wishes of homosexual activities.
- Other factors of power, intimidation, and fear also played significant parts in Jack's entrapment of [REDACTED].

On Monday I immediately began to check Jack's membership status with B.S.A. It was found that Jack was registered in three different places.

Jack's tour permit, which must be filed by each unit leader, for each trip he/she may be taking, was not in our local files. A log sheet did reflect that Jack had filed a tour permit and did have another leader to go with him, as it states in B.S.A. policy; however, [REDACTED] father of [REDACTED] doesn't think any other adult was scheduled to attend this trip.

As these items were being done I was calling the sex crimes unit, Sgt. Orth as instructed by the Hotline to report this case. Sgt. Orth took my information and told me to tell [REDACTED] to call him to set up an appointment as soon as possible with [REDACTED]. This was done on 8/17/89.

Also letter was sent to Jack explaining that because of information that had been brought to our attention, we were revoking his membership in the Heart of America Council, Boy Scouts of America. Also we strongly recommend that he not go on this trip.

This letter was delivered at 4:00 p.m. on August 14, 1989. The parents of the other youth who were scheduled to attend this trip were called and made aware that the trip had been cancelled, due to Jack Stewart's membership being revoked by the Heart of America Council.

The trip has not taken place to date. The police department and the [REDACTED] family are now working to file criminal charges against Jack Stewart.

Boy Scout leader in KC arrested on sex charges

A 69-year-old Kansas City Boy Scout leader was arrested Wednesday after being charged with five counts of deviate sexual assault involving two 16-year-old scouts.

Jack Z. Stewart, of the 3600 block of West Roanoke Drive has been released from custody after posting \$2,500 bond.

He was arrested without incident about noon Wednesday at his home.

This came as a complete surprise to everybody involved," said Detective Ashley Hurn of the sex crimes unit who investigated the case. "He was considered a model leader."

Boy Scout officials told police Stewart had been a Scout for about 25 years. He took groups of three to four boys on "High Adventure" camping trips at least once a year to Canada and northern states.

Detectives did not know

whether Stewart was involved in other Scout activities. Officials at the Heart of America Council of the Boy Scouts of America, which oversees Scouts in parts of Missouri and Kansas, were unavailable for comment today.

According to police records, the boys said they were assaulted in separate incidents at the Scout leader's home.

One boy first notified police about the man in August. He told detectives he had been assaulted several times from April to September 1988.

The second boy told police he was assaulted Jan. 16. The boy described a similar scenario involving a sex act after the boy read pornography.

Police obtained a search warrant and found pornographic stories inside a desk drawer in the basement "Scout Room."

Stewart, who had no police record in Kansas City, refused to discuss the alleged incidents with police, the reports said.
