This past summer when the scout troop was at Camp Sidney Dew there was an incident reported by to his mother about Mr. Burke's touching genital area when was sleeping in Mr. Burke's tent. This incident was reported several weeks after it happened and came about because had noticed that was very agitated and worried when he had to attend Scouts.

My client's are aware that reports of this nature must be seriously considered and investigated before any action should take place. They do not wish to institute criminal charges because of the terrible emotional trauma which the child would have to experience. However, they do want the Boy Scouts of America to investigate this matter and report to them the result of the investigation and any action taken. They will make available, if necessary, to relate his story of this incident. If an expert opinion is necessary to corroborate recounting of the incident then he will be made available at your expense to talk with any proper professional.

It is not the intention of the to injure or harm anyone's character or reputation. It is a past Eagle Scout and he is worried both as a parent and a former scout that an incident like this could do great harm to his child and to an organization for which he has a great deal of respect.

Please consider this letter as a formal complaint the handling of which my clients desire to be done with the utmost care and confidentiality. My clients do not wish this incident to be made public nor reported to any agency or law enforcemnt official. They desire that it be handled as a Boy Scouts of America personnel matter.
