Dear Dick:

I really hated to give you the information about this individual. This came as a shock to us also, but he was accused of molesting scouts from 1980 to 1985. We have signed statements from individuals, who are now in college, who indicated they were molested by Jim Hale. This youth member was apparently a member of Troop 102 and I believe that Jim Hale was associated with this for a period of time.

Apparently the one family, where molestation took place, had known Jim Hale in some other locations. I believe in Hawaii, where he had been involved.

A report was made to Carswell Air Force Base in Texas in March of this year, those statements are in our files.

We, also, have the information which came to us from the Florida Sea Base. Ray Neal had issued instructions that Jim Hale was to be called into the office. A statement was to be read indicating that we had information that he was involved in child abuse for an extended period of time, involving an individual in Okinawa. A letter of resignation was given to Jim Hale which he signed with no protest or denials.

I hope the information I have given you will be of some help to you. I don't know if you could get any additional information if you talked to any individuals that are still associated with Troop 102.

Let me know if you desire any further information.

Jim Hale did transfer from your council to the Florida High Adventure Base. Information came to us at that time related to some sexual abuse charges which occurred when he was in Okinawa.

We did receive written statements from youth members who indicated they had been molested while they were stationed there by Mr. Hale. We have enough information to substantiate this and Jim Hale has been discharged from the profession and is not working at the Florida High Adventure Base.

I am sorry to have to give you this information; however, I hope you can use it as substantiation for deleting his registration from units in your council where he is still registered.

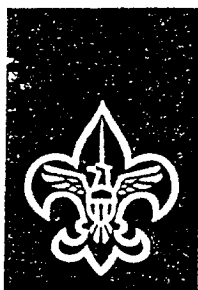

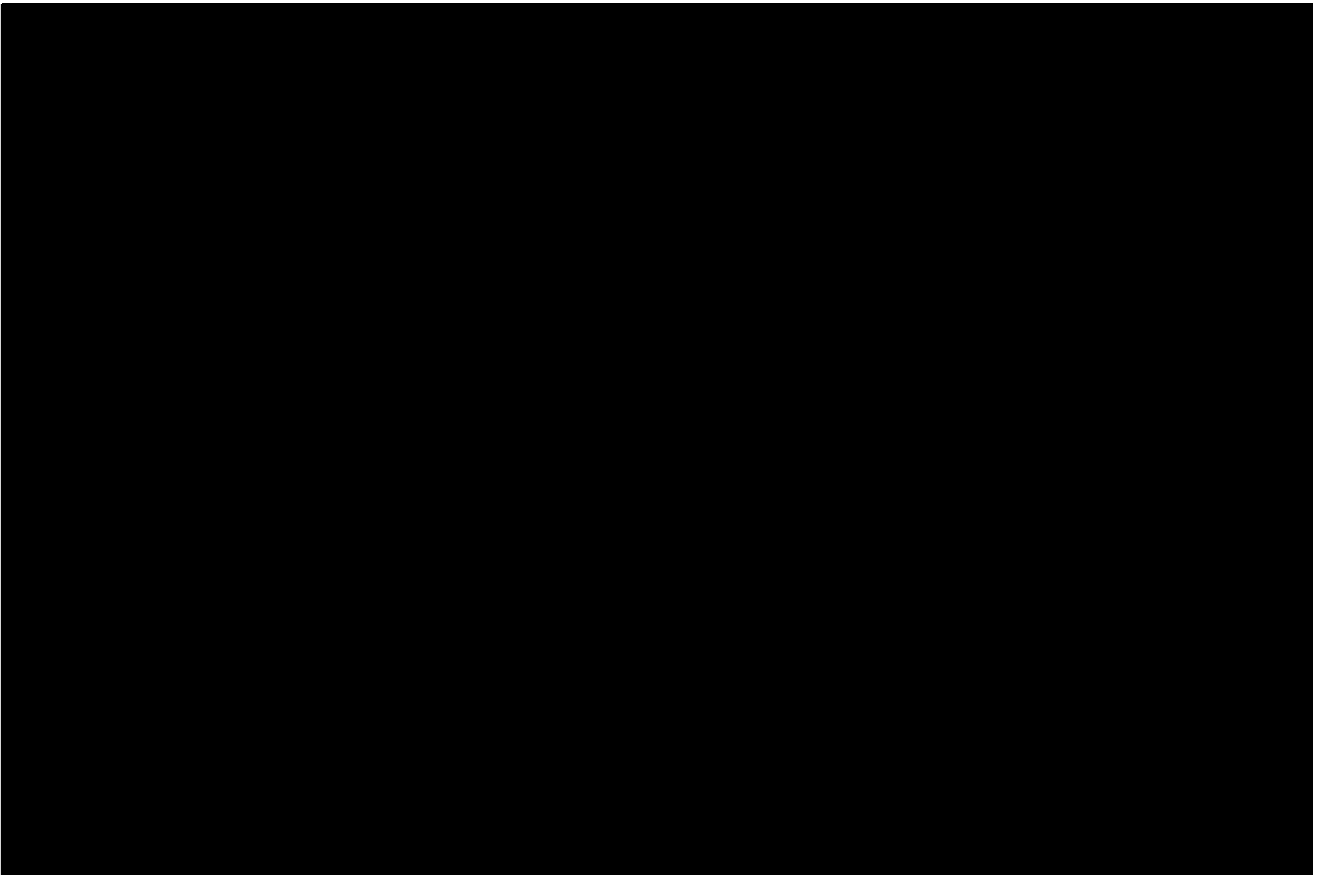

I was down to see [redacted] last weekend and he told me you requested a copy of his statement to OSI and also the names of other boys involved.

He believes [redacted] matches was instrumental in the arrest and sentencing to St. Lawrence of an Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 2 in Okinawa in 1983 or 84. He don't remember the Scoutmaster's name, but we know he worked at the Kadena Hospital.

- Questionable but he was a close friend of Jim's.

I only wish there was something legal we could do to imprison both, but I have been informed by [redacted] at OSI, [redacted] that they only have jurisdiction over [redacted] but because Jim Hale is a civilian they cannot do anything.

It is comforting to know that he will never be able to be around Scouts again, but what about other kids, - Boy's Clubs, YMCA where Jim possibly will apply for a job.

Jim Hale is originally from Pearl City, Hawaii and he was always involved in Scouting there.

[redacted] who in the ^{late} 1970's had warned me of a possible problem with Jim was a Scoutmaster there. Our other son [redacted] was more or less a test in some ways for Jim because he had never done anything out of the ordinary with him, we thought the rumors were only rumors. It is such a sad thing for all the kids he has touched.

Again I want to thank you for such quick action in this matter. He as a family loved Scouting and all of us were deeply involved for several years and I know it is a good program for young boys. I would hate to have it ruined by people like [redacted]

James Hale signed the enclosed letter of resignation and was escorted off Base by Ed Kneller. There were no protests or denials from Mr. Hale.


