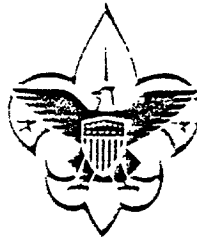



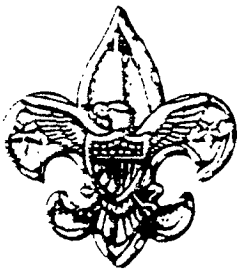

A Boy Scout leader suspected of molesting three members of his troop has been charged with multiple counts of child molestation after a lengthy investigation.

Deputy District Attorney Randy Harris said Monday that charges were filed Thursday against James Antonio Martinez, 37, of La Puente.

Martinez, 37, was charged with molesting three boys on a felony counts of lewd acts on a child, Harris said.

Two of the boys — ages 11 and 12 — allegedly were fondled by Martinez in June 1987 while on an overnight bike trip on the west bank of the San Gabriel River.

Harris said.

The 11-year-old told investigators that he woke up during the night to discover Martinez reaching inside his sleeping bag and fondling his genitals, Harris said.

The child said Martinez told him he was practicing to become a doctor and not to tell anyone what had happened, according to Harris.

The following morning Martinez allegedly fondled both boys while they were showering, Harris said.

The two incidents came to the attention of authorities when Martinez's troop was preparing for another overnight excursion and one of the youths told father that he didn't want to ride in a car

with the scout leader because of what had occurred in the past, Harris said.

The father then called the other boy's father, who reported that his son also had told him of being molested. The fathers then contacted police, Harris said.

Martinez was arrested in April and released. Harris said he did not file charges at the time because he only knew of the incidents involving the two boys.

He said he was concerned he might have a difficult time proving the case against Martinez because the boys were good friends and the incidents occurred almost simultaneously. Harris said he rejected the case

but asked Walnut Sheriff's deputies to continue the investigation.

Investigators subsequently learned of a third boy — now 16 — who was 13 in 1984 when Martinez allegedly molested him, Harris said.

In that case, according to the prosecutor, the boy told investigators that Martinez gave him back rubs, then progressed to fondling his buttocks. The youth said Martinez attempted to fondle his genitals but stopped when the boy protested, Harris said.

Martinez, an engineer for a Covina engineering company, faces a maximum sentence of 40 years in state prison if convicted on all counts, Harris said.

Martinez did not return a telephone call from The Tribune Monday to his workplace.

Harris said he plans to file special circumstance allegations that Martinez was in a position of trust during the alleged incidents.

The allegations, if proved, could add additional time to any prison sentence, Harris said.

Deputy District Attorney Richard Sullivan, deputy in charge of the Citrus office in West Covina, said Monday that a warrant for Martinez's arrest was issued Thursday when the charges were filed.

Sullivan said an arraignment date will be scheduled when Martinez is taken into custody.


Dear Jim:

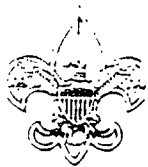
