Dear Mr. Park:

It is with deep regret that I must submit this grievance and petition for your consideration and opinion.

To preface; in eight years of employment history with the BSA. I have always been blessed with honest, open and sincere reciprocal rapport with all professional associates and superiors, that is, until I began associations with Mr. Wayne Taylor, Assistant SC Region Personnel Director, at the advent of having been granted in-transition status this past July, 1987. I requested transition status that I might voluntarily admit myself into resident hospitalization alcoholism treatment. After submitting verifactation of successful treatment to Mr. Taylor, I would contact him 2-3 times monthly by telephone for a reemployment opportunities update to which he would consistently profess to be representing my best interests however there were no DE opennings according to Mr. Taylor, not even entry level and not even nationwide.

Then in December Mr. Taylor denied my reemployment eligibility. I appealed by telephone, in writing, and in person at his SC Region office (with Mr. Benny High, SC Area III representative present). On all occassions he has adamently refused to state why he has coursed his decision to renege. He did refer me to further appeal to Mr. J.L.Grady, National Director of Personnel. I have just received word from Mr. Grady that he thinks it best I persue employment in other areas.

Mr. Park, would you forfeit your career after eight years on the advice of strangers with no reasons given? I think not and add_it is not my decision to do so.

I think it is very possible that this whole situation has arisen out of a simple misunderstanding and possibly someone's propensity to prejudge and /or presume conclusions. I have on four occassions now been denied any detail of "why". Without charges or allegations I can neither enlighten or defend, which is very frustrating.

I fear no reprisals against either my job performance or moral character. I am a producer, upright, and respected as such. If there is some question that the SC Region or National personnel have, why is it kept from me and do they not want to hear my testimony?

I have been courteous, compliant, and civil in my efforts to continue with a normal career and life. However, Mr. Park, I feel I have been treated with callousness, impropriety, and injustice.

Please consider this petition as follows:

- A. I protest the misrepresentation of employment opportunities as presented to me from August through December of 1987.
- B. I protest that a decision was made to terminate my reemployment eligibility without opportunity for any input on my behalf.
- C. I protest the repeated refusals to respond to my requests for a statement of detail as to why said decision was coursed.

THEREFORE: I APPEAL the decision of the Assistant Regional Director of Personnel of the South Central Region to terminate my reemployment eligibility.

I respectfully request:

- A. Reversal of said decision and considerate reemployment assistance, or
- B. An impartial tribunal hearing and determination, or
- C. Compensation for the consequences of this career interuption and possible termination.

Mr. Park, I hope that this situation can be resolved informally and without further escalation. I don't have legal council; wish not to intimidate, but also, I don't want to be intimidated or railroaded into a life/career alteration based on someones misinterpretations, or ignorance or prejudice or self-righteousness or whatever the unknown quantity is.

Thank you in advance for your attention to this matter. I sincerely will pursue the issues and would appreciate any advice you or your office can provide as to due process and form in this concern.

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
