

Every person serving in any official relationship with the Boy Scouts of America shall subscribe to the statement of religious principle, the Scout Oath and Law, and the Bylaws. Each such person either shall be a citizen of the United States or shall satisfy one of the following alternative requirements if applicable to him: (a) A person other than a member of the Executive Board or a regional chairman (all of whom must be citizens of the United States) shall legally declare his intention to become a citizen of the United States; (b) A visiting alien, whether adult or minor shell satisfy the requirements of Article XVI. whether adult or minor, shall satisfy the requirements of Article XVI, Section 6, Clause 4 of the Bylaws.

### CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT, CITIZENSHIP TRAINING, MENTAL AND PHYSICAL FITNESS

The purpose of the Corporation is as set forth in the original certificate of incorporation under the laws of the District of Columbia, dated February 8, 1910, and restated in the Act of Incorporation enacted by the Congress of the United States of America on June 15, 1916, as follows: "That the purpose of this corporation shall be to promote, through organization, and cooperation with other agencies, the ability of boys to do things for themselves and others, to train them in Scoutcraft, and to teach them patriotism, courage, self-reliance, and kindred virtues, using the methods which are now in common use

### DECLARATION OF RELIGIOUS PRINCIPLE

The Boy Scouts of America maintains that no boy can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing his obligation to God. In the first part of the Scout Oath or Promise the boy declares, "On my honor I will do my best to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law." The recognition of God as the ruling and leading power in the universe and the grateful acknowledgment of His favors and blessings are necessary to the best type of citizenship and are wholesome precepts in the education of the growing boy. No matter what the religious faith of the boy may be, this fundamental need of good citizenship should be acent before him. The Boy Scouts of America therefore recognizes the religious element in the training of the boy, but it is absolutely nonsecting in its attitude toward that religious training. Its policy is that the organization of institution with which the Scout is connected shall give definite attention to his religious life.

Only persons willing to subscribe to the declaration of principle shall be entitled to certificates of leadership in carrying out the Scout program. Article II, Section

This is in reply to your letter of 1 Ave. 68, requesting information on James E. Overturf.

Mr. Overturf came to the attention of this Department on 31 Mar 68, in a report filed under Cook County Case Report Number 101774. This report alleged that Mr. Overturf had on that date committed certain sexual acts with a member of his boy scout troop. Subsequent investigation by this unit revealed other similar incidents with other boys of the same troop.

Mr. Overturf was arrested by this Department on 4 Apr 68, on three warrants charging indecent liberates with a child.

On 26 Jul 68 the Cook County Grand Jury indicted Overturf on two counts. At present, this case is pending before the Criminal Court of Cook County.

If we may be of further assistance in this matter, do not hesitate to contact us in this matter.

The request made in the attached carbon copy of your letter was sent to you last Thursday so would assume you received it today in New Brunswick.

On Friday a Mr. Waldron of the Cook County Police called our Council Service Center and informed me on some circumstances which you might want to be knowledgeable of.

The Cook County Police, seeking additional information on Mr. James E. Overturf, sent two investigators to Racine, Wisconsin. They spent most of a day there looking into Mr. Overturf's background in that locality. They had conversations with Mr. Merritt Daane, the Scout Executive, and I would judge with other Scouting people.

The police stated Mr. Overturf had been associated with the Boy Scouts there. While with the Scouts in Racine his residence was in Chicago and he traveled to Racine to maintain a Scouting affiliation with a Racine unit. The police indicated some undesirable experiences had occurred in connection with Mr. Overturf being in Scout Camp last summer at Lyle, Wisconsin.

Friday afternoon I called Mr. Merritt Daane (Scout Executive teacine) and related to him the comments of the police.
