I went to Ransburg Boy Scout camp the week of July 16-22. Jim Goodwin came to our campsite on Tuesday, I think. That night I went to bed on my cot in the tent while Jim and the other told ghost stories. I was sleeping until a storm woke me up. My tentmate was sleeping on his cot, and Jim was laying on the floor. The storm also woke Jim up and he went to tie the tent shut, and told me at that time "I will have to get on your cot if water gets in the tent" (that may not be his exact words). He laid back down on his sleeping bag, a short time later water got under the ground cloth and he got on my cot. When I was laying down with my back towards him facing the tent wall. He tried to put his hand down my underwear in front I pushed his arm away. Then he rubbed his hand on the outside of my underwear near my private. I took my right arm and pushed his hand off again. I sat up and he started to rub my back. I told him to stop. Then I got up off the cot and ~~left the~~

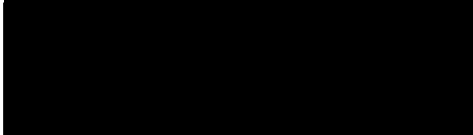
He said "go back to bed!" I said no
I'm getting dressed. Then he got up
and got dressed. We sat there about 20
min. It was 4 AM by my watch. We
both stayed awake in ~~the~~ the tent
until other people got up then we
left the tent. The other scout in
my tent was still asleep. During the
day Jim helped me a lot, he was helping
me on a skill award and camper patch.
I told two of my scout friends
what happened. ~~one~~ (1) said "Don't
worry about it." I didn't report him
because even though even though he
tried he didn't do anything. At bedtime
me Jim and my tentmate all went to
bed. I slept in shorts and underwear be-
cause I was afraid of Jim. I slept on
my side with my back to the tent
wall (Jim was in his sleeping bag on
the floor) with my eyes open Jim tried to
rub my privates. I rolled over and
eventually went to sleep. During the
day again he was helpful. He stayed

in our tent one more night, I think
he didn't try anything, then he moved on
to another tent in our campsite with
adults, I was so embarrassed to ~~the~~
tell anyone, finally I told my mom
about two weeks later.

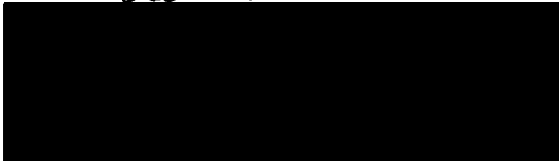

Mother - [Redacted] called to let me know of a situation that happened at Ransburg 7-16 to 22 when her son [Redacted] was at camp. A man named Goodwin was helping them ~~there~~ + only came down for days + did not have a tent. One night when it rained, he slept in a tent with [Redacted]. He shared [Redacted] fold up cot + during the night while [Redacted] was awake with his eyes closed, the man attempted twice to put his hand in [Redacted] pants. [Redacted] [Redacted] Apparently, [Redacted] tent mate had a similar problem. [Redacted] waited 2 weeks to tell his mother + she waited

another week or 2 to tell me trying to decide what to do. She was still very uncertain of telling me [redacted] was afraid to tell his leader (Gary McMills) + afraid to tell his mom.

I assured her she did the right thing. I let her know I would let our Scout Executive know + that we would move from there. I also told her we would let her know how we were proceeding.

I called for Mike Seligra at Rowdrey + left a message with Lou for Mike to call.

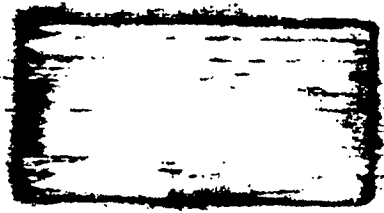
