July 20, 1984 - Received a call from I o, :

She stated that she was in the Plymouth Meeting Scout Shop and recognized Jim Watson. In 1963 or 1964 he had sexually abused her brother, and another Scout. This occurred in Philadelphia in the West Oak Lane section. At that time a meeting was held between Watson, the parents (still alive) and Scout officials. Watson agreed to never associate with Scouting again. No charges were filed.

July 20, 1984, 12:05 p.m. - Called Paul Ernst; he was going to check files to see if any record was filed.

July 23, 1984, 2:10 p.m. - Called Paul Ernst. No record of Jim Watson. He will turn over all available information to Paul Rose to follow up.

I called and asked her permission to forward any information to our National office. I also asked if she would collect any further information. She agreed. Her mother is available and willing to provide any details. One other youth is still in the area. is going to find out if he is willing to make a statement.

2:46 p.m. - Called Philadelphia Council and spoke with Paul Crosson. This is before his tenure in Philadelphia. He is checking and will call back.

All of the above information, plus Paul Crosson; s information, will be forwarded to Paul Ernst for his followup.

3:40 p.m. - Call from Paul Crosson; Philadelphia files do not go back to 1963. They have no information, records, etc. Jim Lanning was the DFS at that time; he is retired.

The situation was totally discust with Jim Watson at approximately 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 6, 1984. The immediate reaction was of both shock and disbelief that allegations of this nature could have surfaced concerning himself. He expressed absolute denial of anything pertaining to the situation and, consequently, felt no need nor desire to submit his resignation.

Jim feels that allegations such as these resulting in an investigation will burt him both personally and professionally merely by inference. He feels quite strongly that upon completion of the investigation proving his innocence, he would like something in writing which would expert him completely.

, Manager of the land of the and can confirm that the conversation was merely to inform him of allegations made by an outside party and that the position of the Boy Scouts of America was merely to be investigative at this point.






