Mrs. will not be available until July 23rd, as they are going away on vacation. She did contact the Westport Police Department but was told that the incident took place outside of their jurisdiction. She was advised to contact the Wareham, Plymouth or Massachusetts State Police. She then contacted Kenneth Candais, who is a Massachusetts State Trooper and father of one of our Scouts. Ken then contacted me and arranged a meeting with Mrs. Her son, and himself at my home on Saturday, July 14th at 5:00 P.M. where I was informed of the alleged incident.
