Dear Paul:

Reference is made to our earlier correspondence concerning James Powell. I have made further investigation of this case and have talked with the detectives, probation officer, and the doctor concerned. Fourth District Court Report #612-306, August 21, 1976, James Lewis Powell was charged with aggravated battery resulting from sexual abuse and lewd and lascivious conduct.

Jim was involved with a Big Brother program, and a male youth testified that over a continued period, including at least five consecutive nights, Jim pulled his shorts off and "beat him off." Jim pleaded guilty and was placed under psychiatric care and a three-year probational period. During his probational period he was not to have association with any youth organization unless approved by both the probation officer and the psychiatric doctor. During this time he was a Scoutmaster with Troop 1 of Meridian, Idaho, attended the National Jamboree and attended the World Jamboree as a Scoutmaster without approval of either. He now has been released from probation. It was after his release from probation that we have learned of this.

The Executive Committee of the Council has met, and we felt that we should take immediate action to request Mr. Powell to sever all relations that he may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A letter was prepared (copy enclosed) and signed by the Council President. Two appointments were made with Mr. Powell to hand deliver the letter. He canceled one appointment and failed to keep the second. His office now reports that he will be out of town for the week. I am leaving for an assignment at Philmont this Saturday and will be gone for the rest of the month. Therefore, we have sent a registered letter to Mr. Powell. This procedure has been verified by phone through your secretary.

This letter is for a written record.

Dear Mr. Ernst:

Reference is made to our letter of June 12th concerning James Powell. As indicated in that letter, efforts were made to have a personal conference with Mr. Powell, and finally a registered letter was mailed to him. We have a written receipt that he received the letter June 16, 1980.

Today, June 30, Mr. Powell came into my office and chatted about his court case, wondering why it just now came up, claimed that a verdict and sentence was not given and that he had received a dismissal of the charges. He supplied a copy of the Dismissal and a letter from the Prosecuting Attorney stating that Mr. Powell's conviction of lewd and lascivious conduct was a computor error and that Mr. Powell had pled to aggravated assault. I assured Mr. Powell that the record I had given the Boy Scouts of America indicated that his plea was aggravated assault.

Mr. Powell stated that he would support Scouting but was dropping out of activity. Enclosed are copies of the documents referred to.

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.

Court accepted the defendant's plea, ordered a pre-sentence investigation and continued the matter for sentencing until May 2, 1977 at 2:30~p.m.


