This is to indicate that I am familiar with Mg. James Lissanski, residing at 1146 E. Horepter Avenue, Philadelphia, Pa., former assistant scoutmaster of Troop 539 Boy Scouts of America.

Mr. Lissanski functioned in our Congregition as assistant scoutmaster up until June, 1962. At that time M Lissanski was asked by me to resign from his post due to a complaint on the part of a parent that Mr. Lissanski had indulged in homosexual activity while fulfilling his duties as assistant scoutmaster. During the course of the meeting with him, Mr. Lissanski confessed to over twenty separate homosexual acts with boys, not only in our scout theop but in two others with whom he was associated.

Please consider this an official request that said James Lissanski be prevented from any future association with scouting on any level

It should also be indicated that our Congregation has attempted to secure parentaric helps for the boy in the hope that he may be helped in overcoming the serious problems that he has.
