Man gets 1 to 3 for sodomy

Judge rules after tearful plea

ALBANY — A Sunday school teacher, described by his attorney as a "pillar of society," tearfully asked Supreme Court Justice Joseph Harris Tuesday to send him to prison if he thought that appropriate punishment for sodomizing a teenage boy — and the judge did.

Harris said he weighed the good deeds of James R. Lewis, an active church member and Explorer Post leader, against the devastation that results from the sexual molestation of a child before sentencing the 45-year-old Colonie man to a 1-to-3-year state prison term.

Lewis and his attorney, Arnold W. Proskin of Loudonville, both argued against a prison sentence, but the defendant wept and told the judge to incarcerate him if he thought it would serve the interests of society.

Harris, presiding over Albany County Court, said Lewis presented a "paradox" as a man who had spent virtually his entire life working for the betterment of his community, yet had "violated the moral fiber of the community" in engaging in sex with a 14-year-old boy.

The interests of society demand that everyone know they cannot violate the law," Harris said.

Lewis, who as of Tuesday was still employed as a digital circuits specialist for the General Electric Research and Development Center in Niskayuna, was arrested last summer and charged with two counts of second-degree sodomy and single counts of third-degree sodomy, third-degree sexual abuse and endangering the welfare of a child.

In a nine-page statement voluntarily given to police, Lewis said he engaged in sex with the boy from July 1986 to June 1988 and had also been involved in a sexual relationship with the youth's brother, who has since died, Assistant District Attorney Veronica Dumas said in court. Dumas said she did not know the brother's age or the circumstances surrounding his death.

Colonie police arrested Lewis after the youth's parents complained.

Lewis pleaded guilty to a single count of third-degree sodomy, a crime which is charged when a victim is too young to lawfully consent to sex but was not physically forced to engage in sexual activity. He could have been sentenced to a maximum term of 1 1/2 to 4 years in state prison.

"What good he has done does not negate the fact that he did commit a crime," prosecutor Dumas said outside the courtroom. "The victim is a child and there was a breach of the trust that an adult owes to a child. Lewis can feel remorse, but the child is the victim."

Lewis, who lives with his parents at 2080 Central Ave., Colonie, is a 1961 graduate of Colonie Central High School, a 1963 graduate of Hudson Valley Community College in Troy and an Army veteran, according to court records. Records show that he has been a Sunday school teacher and board member at Grace Lutheran Church in Schenectady and has been active with a variety of youth organizations, including two Explorer posts.

Defense attorney Proskin portrayed Lewis, who has an otherwise clean record, as a naive man who didn't realize that his actions were wrong, but is genuinely sorry.

"He is admittedly homosexual," Proskin said. "Jim is a very naive individual. Jim Lewis has never done anything wrong in his life. A sentence of incarceration I'm not sure would do Jim Lewis or society any good."

Proskin pleaded for a "strict, severe" sentence of probation.

In a lengthy, emotional address to the court, Lewis apologized profusely, said he was in some ways more like a 12-year-old than a 45-year-old and insisted that although he had done wrong, "there was no malice in my heart whatsoever."

"If you think sending me to jail will belp me or society, I suggest you do it," Lewis told Harris. "But with all my heart, I don't." December 2, 1988

Colonie Man Admits He Sodomized Boy, 14

ALBANY — A 45-year-old General Electric research and development worker pleaded guilty yesterday in Albany County Court to a sodomy charge.

James R. Lewis of 2080 Central Ave., Colonie, a specialist in digital circuitry for GE's corporate Research and Development Center in Niskayuna, initially was indicted on five counts of, sex abuse and sodomy. According to the district attorney's office, his plea to third-degree sodomy is in full satisfaction of that indictment.

Lewis admitted engaging in deviate sexual intercourse with a 14-year-old Colonie boy at his home during the last week of May or the first week of June.

At the time of his arrest, Lewis was accused of abusing the boy over a two-year period. Colonie police said they confiscated sine pornographic videotapes, none of which were homemade, in a search of his home.

Authorities said Lewis worked with a Schenectady-based Boy Scout Explorer Post

and a youth group of Grace Lutheran Church in Schenectady.

In another sex abuse case, 76-year-aid Joseph Kaier of Caroga Lake pleaded guilty to a first-degree sexual abuse charge yester-

According to the district attorney's office, Kafer admitted abusing a 9-year-old Albany girl during the spring of 1984 when he was living with her family.

Also yesterday, 13-year-old John Wolcott of \$4 Grant Ave. was sentenced by County Court Judge John G. Turner Jr. to one to three years in prison on a grand larceny conviction. He was convicted of possessing a 1988 Dodge pickup truck, which had been stolen in Florida, on Aug. 19 on Interstate

In another case, Wayne T. Gray, 32, of 36 Edward St., Coboes, was sentenced by Turner to 60 days in jail, five years probation and a \$500 fine on his his conviction for driving while interiorated. He was arrested Ans. 3 on interstate 87 in the town of Colonie.

Man, 44, Held In Sexual Abuse Of Teen-age Boy

COLONIE — A 44-year-old man faces charges of sodomy, sexual abuse and endangering the welfare of a child, stemming from incidents that took place at his Colonie home during the past two years, police said.

James R. Lewis of 2080 Central Ave., near Lisha Kill Road, was arrested Tuesday night and arraigned before Town Justice Nicholas Greisler, who ordered him held at Albany County Jail without bail to await further court action, police reported yesterday afternoon.

An engineer, Lewis is a specialist in digital circuitry for General Electric's Corporate Research and Development Center on River Road in Niskayuna, police said.

Lewis allegedly sodomized and sexually abused a 15-year-old Albany County boy, whose identity is being kept confidential, police said.

The boy told his parents what allegedly happened to him and the parents called Colonie police on Monday, police said. The boy was interviewed and police got permission to search Lewis's home.

The search took place Tuesday night at \$:30. Police confiscated nine pornographic videotapes. They were not homemade tapes, police noted. Lewis was arrested following the search, said police, who were assisted by Paul DerOhannesian II, Albany County's assistant district attorney who prosecutes child and sex abuse cases.

Police are continuing the investigation.

Colonie man faces sex charges

Active volunteer in youth, church organizations

COLONIE — A 44-year-old electronics expert with ties to at least two youth groups is facing felony charges of sexually abusing a teenage boy over the last two years and investigators are trying to determine whether he has molested other youths, authorities said Wednesday.

The suspect, James R. Lewis, of 2080 Central Ave., was

reported the alleged abuse to police, Colonie Police juvenile unit counselor Patty Schwarz said.

Police said they executed a search warrant at Lewis' home. Tuesday night and seized nine pornographic videotapes.
