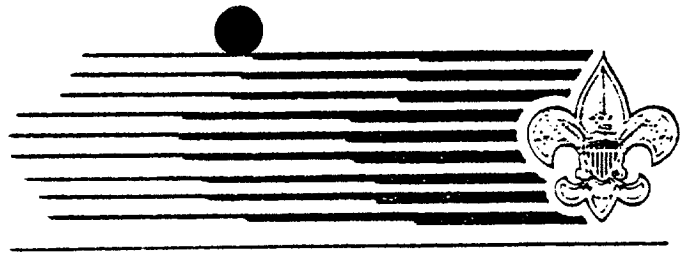

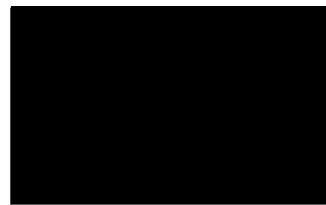

GENERAL COURT-MARTIAL ORDER

Specialist Jody A. Rothmeyer, [REDACTED], U.S. Army, U.S. Army Medical Department - Japan, Unit 45011, [REDACTED] was arraigned at Camp Zama, Japan, on the following offenses at a General Court-Martial convened by Commander, United States Army Japan/IX Corps.

Charge I: Article 125. Plea: Guilty. Finding: Guilty.

Specification 1: Commit sodomy with a child under 16 years of age, by force and without her consent, between August 1989 and September 1989. Plea: Guilty. Finding: Guilty.


SENTENCE

Sentence was adjudged on 26 September 1991. To be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for five years, and to be discharged from the service with a dishonorable discharge.

ACTION

Only so much of the sentence as pertains to reduction to the grade of E-1, confinement for four years and a dishonorable discharge is approved and, except for a dishonorable discharge, will be executed.



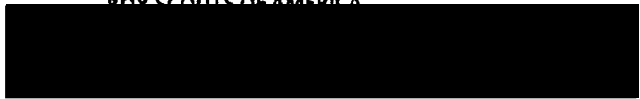

Attached are copies of letters sent to two of our Assistant Scoutmasters here in the Far East Council. They are from Sasebo, which is located about 600 miles south of Tokyo.

The deputy base commander agreed to present the letter to the two of them -- husband and wife.

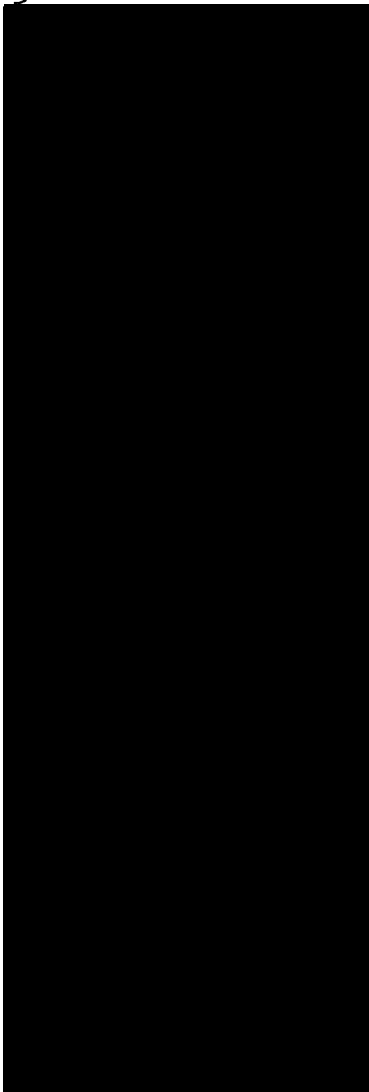
He was arrested by Naval Investigative Services (NIS) for [redacted]

He has admitted to them that he is guilty [redacted]

He has also admitted that the act was committed with his wife's knowledge, on at least three occasions. Thus, she is also under investigation.

The deputy base commander is trying to get me copies of documents, if this is possible. One problem is that he is due to depart Japan late August. I will do my best to secure information about the court-martial proceeding, which I will forward to you.

To date, there is no indication of any child abuse outside of [redacted].


Mr. Rothmeyer.

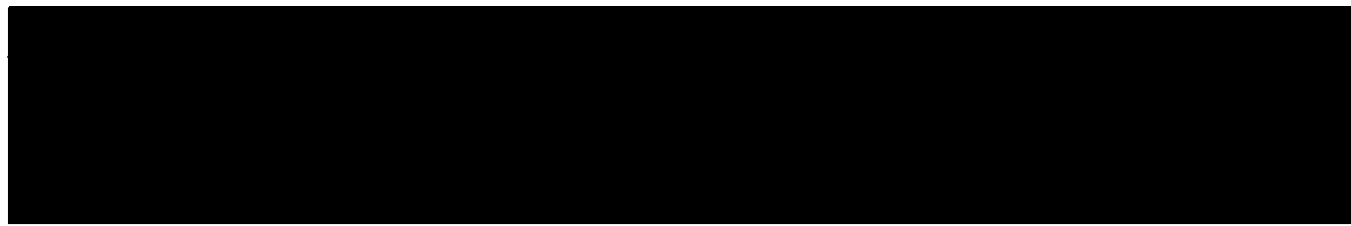
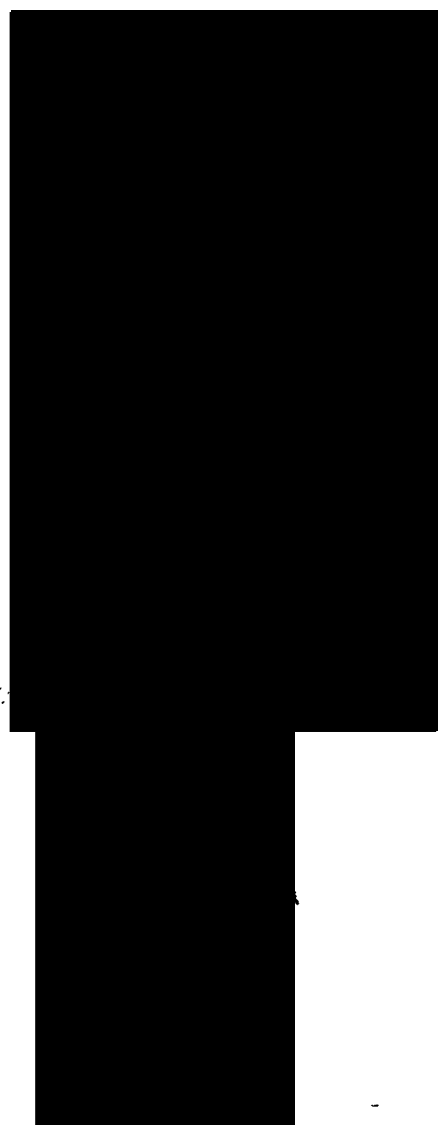
