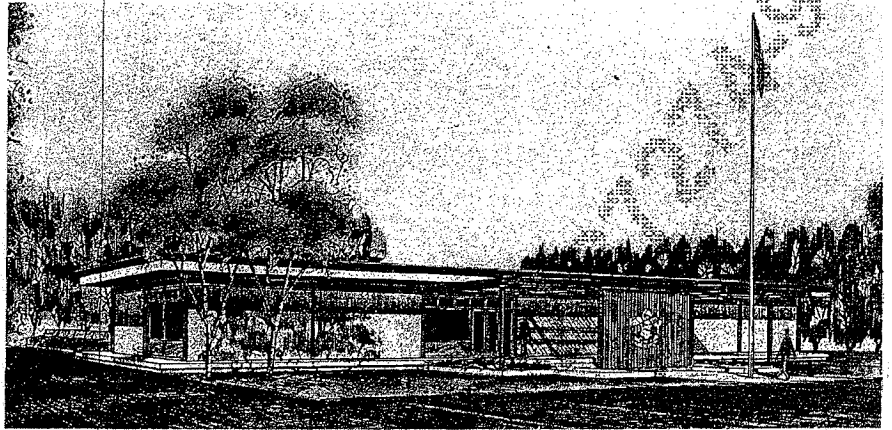

We wish to place Boyd on the "Confidential List" and would appreciate having the necessary forms to give further details.

I have met with the parents of the boys of this troop, as well as with the committee on several occasions, and it appears the troop will continue with a live program and no loss of boys and with greater parental support than ever.

They have a new Scoutmaster and three Assistant Scoutmasters.

The scoutmaster of Boy Scout Troop 30 in Riverside has been jailed on morals charges after he allegedly engaged in unnatural acts with teen-age scouts, police said yesterday.

Detectives said the suspect, John Carlton Boyd, 40, of 4669 Arlington, was freed from Riverside County Jail after posting \$2,000 bail.

According to police reports, Boyd was arrested at his home after admitting abnormal relations with some of the youths in the troop he led.

Detectives said Boyd led them to a hiding place in his basement where some 300 photos of scouts in various nude poses were found.

Boyd, who lists his occupation as a chinchilla rancher, told police he has been in scouting since March, 1950.

A Superior Court hearing will be held at 11 a.m. Feb. 21 to determine whether the former scoutmaster of Boy Scout Troop 30 is a sexual psychopath.

John Carlton Boyd, 40, of 4669 Arlington, Riverside, has pleaded guilty to a felony charge of child molesting—engaging in sex play with boys of the scout troop at his home and taking pictures of some of them in the nude.

A RIVERSIDE police juvenile bureau detective who investigated, said the activities apparently had been carried out over a period of years with a number of boys in their early teens.

If Boyd is ruled by Judge John G. Gabbert to be a sexual psychopath, he may be remanded to Atascadero State Hospital—as is usual in such cases—for treatment before being returned to court for sentencing.

The investigating detective said Boyd has a total disability pension from the Air Force, is a chinchilla rancher, and has been a noon playground director in the city school system.

HE HAD been in scouting for about 13 years, the detective said, and "had an outstanding record."

Numerous nude pictures were recovered by police, they said, from a hiding place in Boyd's home when he was arrested.

Dr. O. L. Gericke and Dr. Philip Lawler, psychiatrists, were appointed to examine Boyd and report their findings to the court prior to the psychopathy hearing.
