In June of 1986, John Petrie was accused and came under investigation for improper touching as stated in a letter from Troop and Post 100 of our Council. John Petrie asked to step down and removed himself from contact with the troop. Mr. Petrie was charged and the venue was moved to Whatcom County where the Whatcom County Prosecutor's Office investigated. Warren Page, of the County Prosecutor's Office, indicted that the case was settled with a deferred prosecution for two years and that the file was sealed so that no records are available. Mr. Page indicated to me that there was a deferred prosecution because the evidence in the case was not strong enough for conviction. After reviewing all circumstances, it was Mr. Page's observation that under no circumstances should Mr. Petrie be allowed involvement with a youth group.

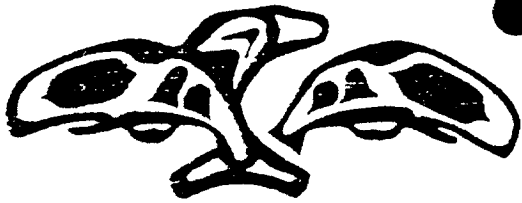

April 3, 1987

Contacted Warren Page in the Whatcom County Prosecutor's Office at [redacted] Bellingham, this date to determine the status or disposition of John Petrie's case.

The case has gone to Deferred Prosecution for two years. This means that no action will be taken for two years provided that John Petrie:

1. Obtains and responds to therapy for sex offenders, and
2. That he have no association with youth or youth organizations in this period.

Mr. Page asked that if we get any information that John Petrie is attempting or has become involved in any youth organization that his office be notified immediately.

Mr. Page also stated that the Deferred Prosecution agreement should be firmed within two to three weeks. I stated that I would contact him at this point to confirm the status.

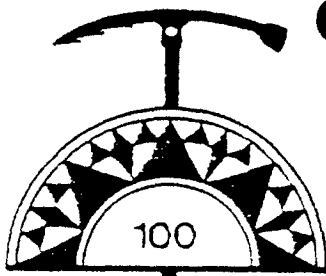

The following is the statement of action, taken by the Parents Group and the Troop Committee, that you asked for regarding Mr. John Petrie:

On June 19, 1986, we called a joint meeting of the Parents Group and the Troop Committee in order to bring out the fact that our Scoutmaster was under investigation for "Improper Touching"; and that he (John Petrie) had offered to step down as Scoutmaster and absent himself from any contact with the boys of the Troop and Post until such time as these charges had been disproven. After a great deal of discussion, we jointly and unanimously decided to accept John Petrie's offer. We then called a second meeting for the following week to elect a new Scoutmaster. On June 26, 1986 we elected, unanimously, Mr Steve Gilbert as our new Scoutmaster.

We have not seen John Petrie at any Scout event since June 19th, nor has he made any attempt to contact us.

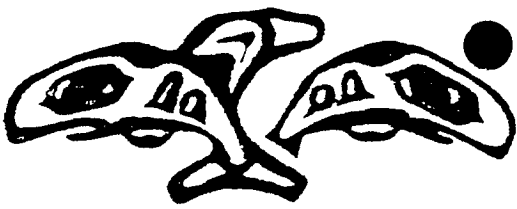
