Purtell pleads guilty to eight sex charges

A Newark man facing 10 charges involving sex offenses pleaded guilty to eight of the charges and no contest to two others.

~~John R. Purtell, 33, 411 Target St.~~ is accused of sexual involvement with five boys, two less than 13 years old and three over the age of 12, but under 15. He pleaded no contest to two counts of gross sexual imposition and guilty to five counts of sexual imposition, two counts of corruption of a minor and one count of gross sexual imposition.

Common Pleas Judge Neil Laughlin accepted the pleas and ordered a presentence investigation and report before sentencing. Purtell remains in the county jail under a \$100,000 cash bond.

He was indicted by the grand jury June 8 after being arrested by Newark police June 7.

Newark man indicted in three sex charges

A Newark man has been indicted by the Licking County grand jury on 10 counts of three sex charges.

John R. Purtell, 33, of 11 Target St., was indicted Wednesday on two counts of corruption of a minor, three counts of gross sexual imposition and five counts of sexual imposition.

The indictment alleges Purtell was sexually involved with five boys, two less than 13 years old and three over the age of 12, but under 15. The incidents reportedly occurred at various times between 1986 and this year.

A press release issued by Licking County Prosecutor Robert Becker last week said the boys were members of a local boy's organization or associated with members of the organization.

Purtell was allegedly involved with the organization, but Becker and Newark police investigators have declined to name the organization, saying it is not relevant to the case. Becker said to name the group would be unfair to the organization.

Purtell is currently in the county jail under a \$10,000 all cash bond set in Municipal Court June 3. He is expected to appear for a Common Pleas Court bond hearing during arraignments Friday morning.

Bond was set at \$100,000 cash during arraignment today for a man charged with sex offenses.

John R. Purtell, 33, of 11 Target St. faces two counts of corruption of a minor, three counts of gross sexual imposition and five counts of sexual imposition.

Ken Oswalt, assistant county prosecutor, told Judge Robert Moore the prosecutor's office was seeking \$10,000 cash bond on each of the counts because the alleged incidents involve children. Purtell is accused of sexual involvement with five boys, two less than 13 years old and three over the age of 12, but under 15.

Purtell was indicted by the grand jury Wednesday. A press release issued last week by the prosecutor's office said the boys were members of a local boys organization or associated with members of the organization. Purtell was allegedly involved with the organization, but prosecutors and Newark police investigators have declined to name the group.

Purtell was suspended from his volunteer position June 1 by Boy Scouts Central Ohio Council 441, said Steve Ayers, a member of the executive council.

Purtell is in the Licking County jail in lieu of \$100,000 bond.

Purtell remained in City Jail at press time today, awaiting a 1 p.m. arraignment on the charge in Licking County Municipal Court.

Police investigate sexual abuse

NEWARK ADVOCATE - 6/4/88

A local man arrested on a warrant charging him with corruption of a minor remains in jail today following a court arraignment Friday.

John R. Purtell, 33, of 11 Target St., was ordered held in lieu of posting a \$10,000 all cash bond set by Judge Gregory Frost in Licking County Municipal Court.

Newark police and Children Services are conducting an on-going investigation into allegations of sexual abuse, according to a press release from the county prosecutor's office.

"The allegations involve minor

male children all of whom were members of a local boy's organization or associated with members of the organization," the release states. No information was available about Purtell's alleged ties to the unnamed group and investigators have declined to name the organization. Past and present members of the unrevealed group apparently are being contacted by Children Services.

"Because of the sensitive nature of the investigation and because it is on-going, no further information can be released at this time," County

Prosecutor Robert Becker said in the release.

However, the prosecutor's office said multiple charges involving Purtell will most likely be presented to the Licking County grand jury June 8.

According to the arrest warrant, Purtell is accused of sexual conduct with a boy over the age of 12 but under 15 on April 2. Corruption of a minor is a third-degree felony.

- Detective Capt. Al Zellner of NPD said there are no other suspects in the case.
