

# Ex-troop leader gets four years in sexual assault of Boy Scout

**TOMS RIVER** — A former Waretown Boy Scout leader was sentenced to four years in the state Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center at Avenel, Woodbridge Township, yesterday after pleading guilty last September to sexually assaulting a 15-year-old Boy Scout.

John Fitzgerald, who lived at the Brookville Boy Scout Camp, Brookville Road, Waretown (Ocean Township) with his father, stood before Superior Court Judge Donald F. Campbell yesterday and apologized for his crimes, admitted he needed counseling and asked the court to provide it.

"I do feel sorry for what I did," Fitzgerald said yesterday.

"I just did this two times and I know I need help. I beg the court's indulgence and leniency," he said.

Fitzgerald pleaded guilty Sept. 13 to two counts of third-degree sexual assault, which carries a five-year maximum jail sentence for each.

According to the Ocean County prosecutor's office, Fitzgerald was arrested May 28, 1988, and charged with sexually assaulting the boy on two separate occasions at the Boy Scout camp.

The first incident was in March 1987, when Fitzgerald invited the boy to help clean up the camp, officials said. The second happened March 21 1988, when the victim was staying at the camp with his Scout troop, according to the prosecutor's office. Fitzgerald was 31 at the time of the second offense.

The victim's Scoutmaster reported the assault. Fitzgerald worked in Stafford Township, and was the committee chairman for local Boy Scout Troop 26, Waretown, and a coach with the Barnegat Pee Wee soccer team.

Fitzgerald was examined by state physicians, a requirement under state law for all sex offenders. The test results found Fitzgerald to have the propensity for being a repetitive and compulsive offender of this type of crime, said George K. Koukos, Fitzgerald's public defender.

Fitzgerald told Campbell he would accept the findings of the state doctors.

# County urging Waretown to

WARETOWN — Ocean Township's month-old policy of collecting and selling recyclable aluminum may jeopardize its ability to dispose of other recyclables through county facilities.

If the township continues to remove aluminum from its recyclable waste stream, the county would refuse to accept the township's glass and tin recyclables, unless the items were separated and the glass was sorted by color, County Recycling Coordinator John Haas said yesterday.

"The vendors which accept the material from us depend on a certain content of aluminum to make their money," he said. "We are competing with many other counties and sources to get

rid of the recyclable material. Our contract with them specifies a certain percentage of aluminum.

"The county must maintain the quality of the material it is offering," Haas said.

But township Committeewoman Maria Szczech said the county should be praising the township's efforts to make its recycling self-sufficient instead of crippling the program.

"We are trying to be as innovative and self-sufficient as possible," Mrs. Szczech said. "We have no contract with the county for recyclables. What are the rules? They are unwritten."

Mrs. Szczech said she believes the county is obligated under its Solid Waste Management Plan to collect the recyclable material whether or not it includes aluminum.

But Haas said that is not so.

We are not required to accept it; towns' responsibility, Haas said.

"The county would simply refuse to accept the material," Haas said. "We would have to try to find a market for their material. We would have to have their men separate and sort the glass by color."

Haas said some companies will accept recyclable material if it is separated and sorted.

"Quality control (of the content of the recyclables the county disposes of) is the bottom line," Haas said.

The issue came to light Tuesday when the Southern Ocean County Recycling Facility in Stafford Township refused to accept a load of township recyclables from which aluminum was removed. The load was only after municipal employees mixed

# Scout leader pleads guilty to molesting teenage boy

**TOMS RIVER** -- A former Boy Scout leader has pleaded guilty to sexually assaulting one of his scouts.

In the plea entered before Superior Judge Peter J. Giovine Tuesday, John Fitzgerald of Waretown pleaded guilty to two counts of sexual contact and one count of endangering the welfare of a child.

Charges of aggravated criminal sexual contact were dropped against Fitzgerald in the plea agreement.

He is free on \$15,000 bail pending sentencing.

Fitzgerald was committee chairman for Boy Scout Troop 26 in Waretown and a Pee Wee soccer coach in Barnegat living at the Brookville Scout Reservation in Waretown when he sexually assaulted a 15-year-old boy between October 1985 and May 1988.

Also pleading guilty before Giovine last week was Gregory Canellis of Heron Road, Tuckerton, to impairing the morals of a minor between March 12, 1984 and March 12, 1988.

"Don't forget the mortgage," said Freeholder H. George Buckwald of the county is building an association.

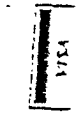
Freeholder James Mancini, also mayor of Long Beach Township, said people are so fond of the course in Little Egg Harbor Township they're asking when the county will buy another one.

## Leader of Scouts is jailed

Police charge him  
in teen's sex assault

TOMS RIVER — A 31-year-old Boy Scout leader was being held in the Ocean County Jail last night on charges of sexually assaulting a 15-year-old Boy Scout.

John Fitzgerald, who lives at the Brookville Scout Reservation, Brookville Road, Waretown, was charged yesterday by Ocean County Prosecutor James W. Holzapfel with two counts of aggravated criminal sexual contact and one count of endangering the welfare of a child.

Fitzgerald was being held in lieu of \$15,000 bail, officials said.

According to a statement released yesterday by Holzapfel's office, Fitzgerald sexually assaulted the same boy on two separate occasions at the camp.

The first incident was in March 1987, when Fitzgerald invited the boy to help clean up the camp, officials said. The second happened March 21 of this year, when the victim was

staying at the camp with his Scout troop, according to the statement.

Michael Murray, a spokesman for Holzapfel, said last night that the prosecutor's office arrested Fitzgerald at 2 p.m. yesterday after the victim's scoutmaster reported the assaults.

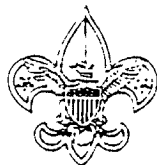
Fitzgerald, who works in Stafford

Township, is committee chairman for local Boy Scout Troop 26, Waretown, and is a coach with the Barnegat Pee Wee soccer team.

No one from the Boy Scouts of America's Ocean County Council could be reached for comment last night.
