

I discussed the Boy Scouts of America's recent concerns in Youth Protection and the changes in procedures that have happened in the last couple of years. I called Mr. Rivers attention to the fact that concerns had surfaced around him about 1982 and 83 and were sufficient for us to request that he not seek registration in the Boy Scouts of America. Mr. Rivers expressed concern in that he thought the records for all of these issues were sealed and stated that he would talk with his attorney about access to such records.

Because there were people passing back and forth in the immediate vicinity, I did not read the letter to Mr. Rivers, but gave it to him to read. Mr. Rivers read the letter and returned it to me stating that he did not need to retain a copy of the letter. Mr. Rivers obviously was not happy with the discussion and he was not outwardly hostile or aggressive nor did he make any statements of any anticipated actions. We shook hands and departed.


