Find enclosed the complete file, as we have it, on the Evans case. Father Jones and I have been meeting together often on a number of items and have delayed the letter till now because of efforts to obtain jon's social sec. #. Those efforts have not been positive to this point. We have now sent to you all we can about him. If the needed number comes to the surface in the future I will send it.

In my conversations with Father Jones he is willing to tell of Jon's potential as a child molester. In his letter he used the confidentiality between a Priest and Parishioner as a reason for not being willing to put it in writing. He has confronted Jon about this in his office and Jon has not been back to a Troop meeting since that time. Father Jones feels that we have taken the needed steps to prevent a child abuse case from occuring in the future. He is grateful.

We have since built the troop back in both numbers and quality of program. We now have a new Cub Pack sponsored at that Church. All is positive and people are pleased.

We have had one of our sponsors refuse to sign their charter because of one of the adults name being included. As asked in one of the notices. I am notifying you of this.

The sponsor is St. Paul's Episcopal Church. located at Kennewick. Wa. 99336. Phone number is Father Julian Jones is the Institutional They sponsor both a troop and a post and will soon have a cub pack. Their troop has, in the past, been a excallent one with a waiting list of boys wanting to join. The troop has over 377 months of tenure.

A meeting was held with the committee chairman. Father Jones and myself, to discuss the up-coming annual charter. During the meeting Father Jones stated that he had reason to fear that the individual in question could be a child molaster and he wanted to keep him away from youth. He also expressed his feelings that the reason the troop was losing membership, (down from 56 in 89 to 6 active in 90) was this persons involvement. Mr John Stidel stated that parents were expressing concern to him about "dropping my son off at troop meetings with 'him' here". Mr Stidel also stated that he was giving boys rides home after troop meetings with "just the two of them in the car".

Paul, the person they are concerned about is Jon Evans. He lives at in Kennewick. Wa. He was born 06-19-53 99336. Phone number (37). Jon is single. He is about 5' 8" and around 180 lbs. He has red hair, comoed straight back, and a full beard which he keeps about 8 to 10 inches long, combed to a point. He moved here in 1987 from Portland, Oregon. His address , Portland. Oragon. . He is a members of the Order of the Arrow and

wears the Eagle Knot. Was registered as Assistant Scoutmaster in the above troop.

A visit with Jon has been held during which he was notified of the wishes of his church. He was also told that he was not to attend troop. District, or Council events nor could he be registered in any district or council position. If he did attend any of the above he would do so as a visitor and not as a member of the BSA.

I hope this letter answers this difficult situation and meets the needs of the BSA.

Dear Ray:

Pursuant to your request, I submit the following concerns which I have had about Jon Evans working with Troop #169 which we sponsor.

You must realize that as a priest I can't break confidentiality with a parishioner. However, I can share with you in a general way the reasons why I feel that it is not appropriate for Mr. Evans to be working with the Boy Scouts of America.

He has taken boys home from Scout meetings on an individual basis. Although he is aware that this is strictly prohibited, he continued to do it several times.

He told many outrageous stories which had no basis in fact, attempting to win the adulation and approval of the boys. Among them was his repeated stories about he being a pilot, flying 747's to Saudi Arabia to transport troops during the Gulf War. In checking with the F.F.A., we find no evidence that Mr. Evans is a licensed pilot of any kind.

The troop was declining in numbers as the boys were turned off by his actions. Parents and troop leaders were getting discouraged and we were concerned that the troop might fail if he continued to participate.

Generally speaking, I did not find him to be a wholesome, moral example of what a scout leader should be, and therefore I declined to approve his name on the charter.

If I can be of any further assistance, please let me know.
