



During the inter~~view~~viewing of people involved with a gay party in the City a report was received that a person involved in this type of activity was a teacher in the Elyria schools. The only description that was attainable was that the persons first name was Joe, that he had short black hair, wore heavy rimmed glasses, had a Ford Convertible black in color, and was a teacher in the Special classes at Elyria High School.

Inquiry it at the school gave the Officer the information that one Joe Glick answered the description and that he was a teacher in Special classes.

Permission was obtained from the Mother of the boy involved to handle the matter through the Office of Dr Gottfried.

Officer Graham contacted Doctor Gottfried on Wednesday morning and he immediately requested the presence of Wayne McCullin and Mr Glick in his Office. The information was presented to Mr Glick and how it would be handled in regard for the school system. Mr Glick admitted the accusation was true and was immediately asked to resign by Dr Gottfried and this he did. He was asked to collect his property and return to Columbus, Ohio his home by Friday April 27, 1962. This he agreed to do.
