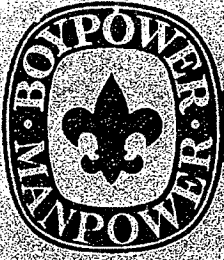

Mr. Joseph T. Faubion, Post Advisor of Post 45 sponsored by Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church should be placed on the Confidential file immediately. This Chapter was due December 31st and this man will not be re-registered in this council.

We have written and signed statements from boys stating the fact that this man has provided alcoholic beverages at meetings and on several occasions has exhibited pornographic films for several members of the scouting unit. There are also strong implications of homosexual activity. During our investigation of this matter he has also threatened and intimidated boys and their families.

At the present time we are dealing with legal authorities on how we will proceed, but in the meantime this man must not be accepted for registration. He is 24 years old and has been registered in this council for one year, coming to us from Manhattan. At the present time Manhattan is checking him out.

I saw at 45 Van Wagoner Ave. Mr. Tawbon give liquor and show stag films to [redacted] [redacted] and [redacted] getting [redacted] drunk. I saw them show films to boys at 45 Van Wagoner Ave and also at 104 Corbin Ave. Mr. [redacted] also at the Post Christmas Parties gave liquor to the boys and spike the punch with half a bottle of gin and a full bottle of ~~champagne~~ champagne.

On the 18 of Jan. 1969 Sat. night [redacted] and I went up to Joe Tawbon's house and ~~see~~ Joe wanted [redacted] to do something but [redacted] said "no" Joe Tawbon then said in curse words for [redacted] to leave and never to come back. So we left.

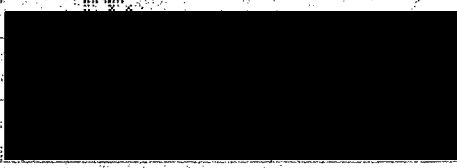

Mr. Joseph Faubion has admitted to me he is a homo-sexual. In his own words, he said, "I am gay." He has showered me with gifts and favors, innocent enough, considering me his "little buddy." He asked me (more than once) to go in bed with him. Refusing and criticizing criticizing him, he would always then ask, "Not even out of friendship?" Since the first time he asked me, I no longer considered him a friend or a safe person to be with. Numerous times, I tried to quit the post, but he would let me. Any other boy, yes, me, no. ~~to~~ Mr. Faubion went as far as not having me pay dues, having to attend activities, and doing very little work in the post. As he told me, "I'll do anything to keep you in the post and I don't want you to leave or go back to Boy Scouts." ~~He has shown~~ He has shown pornographic films to me, ~~alone~~ alone. He made attempts to "play" with me, whereas, I had to use force to get away from him. He would never show such films to me if there were other boys to watch. I've watched him give liquor to young boys. He has also given me liquor (many, many times, alone). Mr. Faubion asked me (alone) was there anything, ~~as~~ anything he could that would get me in bed with him. I said nothing could, absolutely nothing could. It only made him more determined, him saying he'd never give up.

~~He~~ Mr. Joseph Faubion told me (aloud) he never touch me without my permission or use force. But he was lying to me. Many times he tried to get me, in anyway, but there was no way. Then ~~the~~ this ~~attorney~~ ~~to~~ ~~the~~ "advisor" of our post gave me an ultimatum. Either I was to "strip" in front of him, he "strip" him, or go in bed with him. I refused and he told me to come up later that night (I had to come to pick up something belonging to me.) That night (January 18, 1969) I came up, bringing a friend to wait outside if I need help. I knocked and when he knew it ~~was~~ was me, he told me to come in (door was unlatched). The whole ~~and~~ house was dark. I asked to open the light. He was in bed, got up, I saw his silhouette against a window. I thought he was naked. Turning on a light, he was in his dirty, filthy underwear. Going back in bed, he half covered himself. "Well," he said I nodded no. His smile turned into a frown, a steady one. He just stared and stared at me. I got my ~~shoes~~ shoes (which I had left there before because I broke them) and then my friend rang the buzzer. Mr. Faubion, without asking who it was, let him in by telling ~~to~~ whoever it was to come in. My friend had thought I was in trouble. Mr. Faubion returned to his staring at me. When we told him we were leaving, He broke his silence with an outburst. "Well,

Mr. —, since you can't keep your word with me (where I got that idea I don't know) you can go fuck yourself and as far as I'm concerned you will never be allowed in this house again!" choking on his last words. As for myself, Mr. Joseph Faubion only got as far as putting his ~~hand~~ arms around my neck, playing with the hair on my head, sitting on my lap (once, whereas I picked him up and threw him on a table, breaking it. After I warned him to get off me and he dared me to stop him), putting his hand on my knee for awhile, but what hurt the most was his long, silent stares.

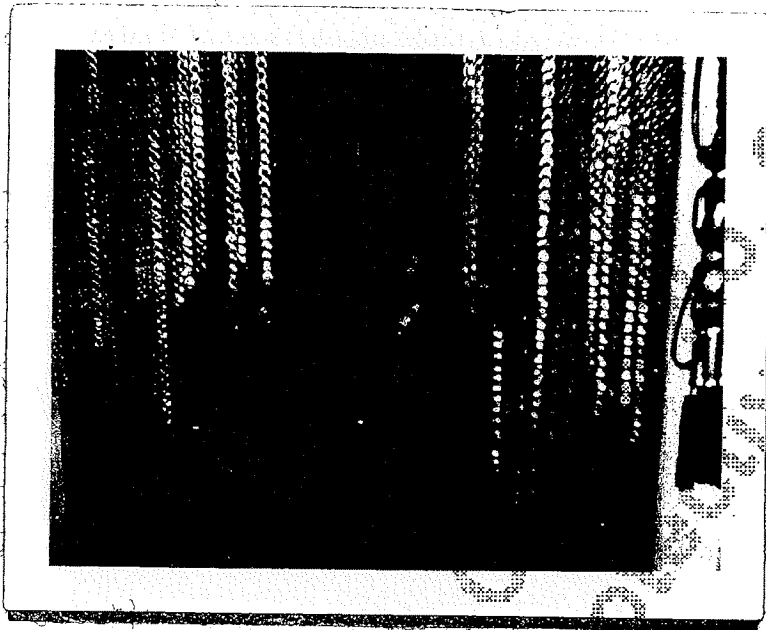
