# Berkeley Scoutmaster Awaits Sentence in Sex Case

## Staff and Wire Reports

A 70-year-old Berkeley scoutmaster will have to register as a sex offender and another Northern California Boy Scout leader has received a 10-year prison sentence in connection with molesting young boys.

Julian Adams, who has been a scoutmaster in Berkeley for more than 30 years, pleaded guilty on August 9 in Berkeley-Albany Municipal Court to two counts of child molesting involving a young boy who was in his troop. Adams will be sentenced next month.

Adams was originally charged with two other counts of molestation involving two other boys, but those charges were dropped as part of a plea bargain that will place Adams on five years probation and will require him to register as a sex offender, said Berkeley Police Lieutenant Michel de Latour, who was chief investigator in the case.

Meanwhile, former Galt scoutmaster Allen Lee Trueman, who was that city's 1988 "Citizen of the Year," was sentenced to 10 years in prison Wednesday in Sacramento County Superior Court after pleading guilty to three counts of lewd

Lee Sneath, a national spokesman for the Boy Scouts of America, said more incidents involving sexual contact between leaders and Boy Scouts have been reported in recent years following the adoption of a major anti-child-abuse program.

"Within the last couple of years we've been encouraging the boys to 'yell and tell' and while it appears there has been an increase in this sort of thing, it may be more that the boys are speaking up in the min-

iscale number of cases that do exist," Sneath said.

De Latour said that the investigation in the Berkeley case began after one of the victims went to the police and told them he had been molested while working at Adams' cabin in St. Helena last fall.

De Latour, who is himself active in scouting, said that "the issue is not scouting, the issue is that pedophiles exist in society and parents need to understand how they can

minimize risk no matter whether the situation is a sports team or a school event or scouting or whatever."

"Check out the motives of the people involved," De Latour said. "If it is a parent coaching their own child, too, the risks are very reduced."

"The chances of problems are also much less if at least one parent goes on outings," he said.

# Planes Collide Near Tracy — 2 Killed

Two people died yesterday when two small private planes collided over a remote rural area in San Joaquin County near Tracy.

The planes were a Cessna 180 and a Beechcraft Baron, investigators said. Authorities said there was only one person in each plane. Larry Bret Fitchman, 59, of Novato was identified as one pilot. The name of the other pilot was withheld.

Investigator in the Federal Aviation Administration, the National Transportation Safety Board and the San Joaquin County Sher-

Humphries apparently was flying low over I-580 near Altamont Pass to navigate his way to the Livermore Airport beneath a thick layer of clouds.
