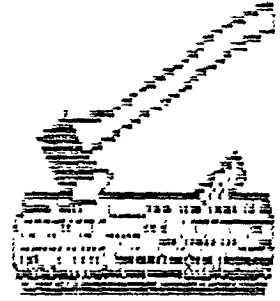

[REDACTED] and I would like to wish you a happy holiday season, and a prosperous new year. We hope that you and your family had a very merry Christmas. We are both grateful for the good experience Wood Badge has brought into our home. I have really enjoyed serving with you, in fact those times are some of the choicest experiences I have ever had.



It is with a very heavy heart, and much sorrow that I have to inform you that I will not be able to serve on your Wood Badge course. In fact it looks like I will be unable to serve in any Scouting capacity. About a week ago I received a letter from Harvey Mortensen stating that my membership in the BSA should be terminated. The reason that he expressed is that I do "not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth". There is a good possibility that I will serve some time in prison. I am just getting started in a mental health program.

A few years ago I was feeling very low, and not accepted by anyone. On a scale of 1 to 10 my self esteem was a 0. I was willing to do anything to be accepted by someone, and to be important to them. In my profession as an auto mechanic I was doing poorly, making less money than ever before. In Church on Sundays someone would always say something to make me aware that I should be married, and they have this great friend or relative they would like me to meet. I know that their intentions were

good, but it still had a bad effect on me. Along comes one of my [REDACTED] A boys that shows me he really cares about me. Later he becomes one of my Scouts. We became good friends. I felt like he was the only one in the whole world that really cared about me. I really cared about him. We would do many things together like patch trading, help with homework, attend church, sports of all kinds, karate, and all kinds of good and wholesome things including scouting. Things started changing when he would want to stay at my place overnight. I would let him stay if he had permission to stay. I lost control and got into a really badly twisted relationship. A few months later I was able to get control of my self and discontinue the improper things that were happening, but it was too late. I had destroyed a child's life.

Now it is a few years later. I disclosed the details of my actions to my Bishop, and then to my Stake President just prior to our Temple marriage. We worked through the Spiritual repentance process, before our wedding. I feel that my Heavenly Father has forgiven me, but I still have to work through the civil repentance process. Both me and the boy are getting some professional counseling. The details have been voluntarily disclosed to the police who are taking action at this time. No charges have been filed against me yet, but they will be soon. I assume that the police are the ones that talked to the Scout office about the situation, which resulted in the letter I got from Harvey Mortensen.

It was really out of character for me to sexually abuse him. I really love this young man, and I find it difficult to believe

that I was capable of doing that. I have made a promise to my Heavenly Father that it would never happen again, and I fully intend to keep that promise. The courts need to be sure that it will never happen again, so I will be involved in whatever program the judge feels is appropriate.

I hope and pray that the decision that Harvey made is not a permanent one. I love the feeling of serving in Scouting, and especially in Wood Badge. I would hope that the BSA would be forgiving when they are sure that nothing inappropriate would happen again. If there is any way possible, I would like to have my membership in the BSA reinstated (sometime in the future). Brent, I would really appreciate your faith and prayers as we go through these times of sore trials. [REDACTED] and I both need to be strengthened spiritually, emotionally and physically for the things which are to come.

It is difficult to tell you of these things because they will disappoint you and others. I am really sorry that they ever happened. If I had one wish it would be do things over again without the inappropriate behavior. You have been such a good example and a good friend to me. Thank you for all that you have done. I really hope that we will be able to remain friends in brotherhood and scouting.


Dear Mr. Williams:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be terminated. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish this decision to have an internal review, please write or call me at the council office, ██████████, within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated.
